THE FALLAS START

1. Crida

Held on the last Sunday of February in the Serrano Towers at 20:00h
Remember to arrive early and
DO NOT bring glass bottles or alcohol.

2. Mascletades

From the 1st to the 19th of March at 14:00h in Plaza del Ayuntamiento (Town Hall Square).
Do not bring pushchairs, bicycles, scooters or similar items.
Do not bring anything that could endanger other people.



OFFERINGS TO THE VIRGIN

3. Offerings to the Virgin:

On March 17 and 18 at Plaza de la Virgen (Virgin Square).
Do not obstruct the passage of the commissions.
Follow the instructions of the authorities.
Use the designated crossings to cross.



FIREWORKS

4. Fireworks

Respect the areas reserved for the public and DO NOT leave rubbish in your surroundings, Valencia is a clean city.
Call 092 if you see firecrackers in prohibited areas.

DURING THE FESTIVITIES...

5. Prohibited activities subject to penalties

- Throwing firecrackers in areas not designated for this purpose and outside the permitted hours.
- Leaving rubbish or glass waste ignoring the litter bins and rubbish bins set up for this purpose.
- It is strictly forbidden to urinate on the public streets, please use the portable toilets.



REPORT ANY KIND OF SEXUAL AGGRESSION

6. Sexual assaults prevention

- Go to any purple information point. Valencia Local Police has specialised personnel for handling this type of crime.
- As a victim you will be our priority. Call 092 or 112 in case you witness this type of aggression.

7. Theft and robbery

- Try to carry only the essentials.
- Never lose sight of your belongings.
- Keep your most valuable items in your front pockets.
 - Try not to go alone.
- Avoid large crowds.
