BARON DE SANTA BARBARA MANSION

Actually the oldest house in Massarrojos. It is a building by the end of Middle Age by XV century, of large dimensions, that in spite of alterations suffered during XX century, still keeps the original structure. Originally, the heritage hold, two houses, one small (by the left) and the Main one (to the right) with attic, wine cellar and stable, furthermore an orchard of 9 “hanegadas”, closed with a Valencian wall. In 1735 year, Josefa Colomer y Aznar created in Massarrojos the link of Rodriguez de la Encina, stately family from Onteniente linked to the title of Baron of Santa Barbara (1799) owner of the mansion. In 1882 the Baron sold the main house and the orchard to Corell’s Family that actually remain their owners. Repentant by the decision, tried to recover it but without success, so, they bought another house at the village.
