LA ASUNCION Y SANTA BARBARA CHURCH

It is an independent Parrish since the year 1902. The older part of the building is the central nave which is shaped like a barrack and was built in 1736. While growing the village population, in 1864, the temple was enlarged and was added to other dependencies. Enlargement that was finished in 1929 with the construction of aisles and adding the Bell Tower to the whole. Inside, baroque decoration, keeps the images of “Santos de la Piedra and the Santa Barbara”, saint patrons of Massarrojos, as well as, the tomb of venerable Jose Bau Burguet (the first priest of the independent parrish). It should be noted the door with the shield of the stonemasons and, especially the Bell Tower that was finished on July 7th of 1895, it was constructed (during 8 years, only on bank holidays) by the stone masons of Massarrojos from local quarry of Badall.
