NICOLAU PRIMITIU'S MANOR

A house of big dimensions with a stately character that originally formed a unit with the right one that was divided during the second part of the XIX century. Historically, as from XVII century was linked the noble family of Alonso de Pisana, a native of Ayora. Both houses belonged to “Dels Fariner’s (Senent Ibañez) family, that gave illustrious people to the village as Jose Senent Ibañez and Joan Senent Anaya. On the exterior of the house (towards the right) and with a ceramic tile of the Saint Vicente (XIX century) to the right. During the XX century as a result of his marriage with “Tonica la Farinera”, the patriarch of Valencian culture D. Nicolau Primitiu Gomez Serrano, used to live long seasons with his family. The monument to his memory of the sculptor, Alfredo Llorens García and erected at the square, looks at what his house was.
