





Monthly average temperature. 2018




Climate diagram. 2018



Population Pyramid. Comparison 1900 and 2019


























Active and unemployed population EAPS. Annual average 2018




Evolution of the employed persons. EAPS.2018


















Percentage of votes regarding votes to candidatures
