

Archiduque Carlos Street, one of the biggest streets in the city nowadays, which connects with the Picanya and Torrent motorway, functionally replaced in the XX century the old Torrent road, which followed the route of today's streets Maestro Bellver, Enrique Olmos, Pintor Pascual Capuz and Alquería de Benlloch.

That old road was one of the most used communication routes around the city since the Middle Ages and for centuries, always busy with farmers' carts and carriages, which inspired this saying:

“Al camí vell de Torrent

tot són clots i ‘carrilaes’; les pessetes i l’or

‘pa’ les xiquetes més ‘templaes’”

“In the old road of Torrent,

it's all potholes and ruts; pesetas and gold

for the prettiest girls”
