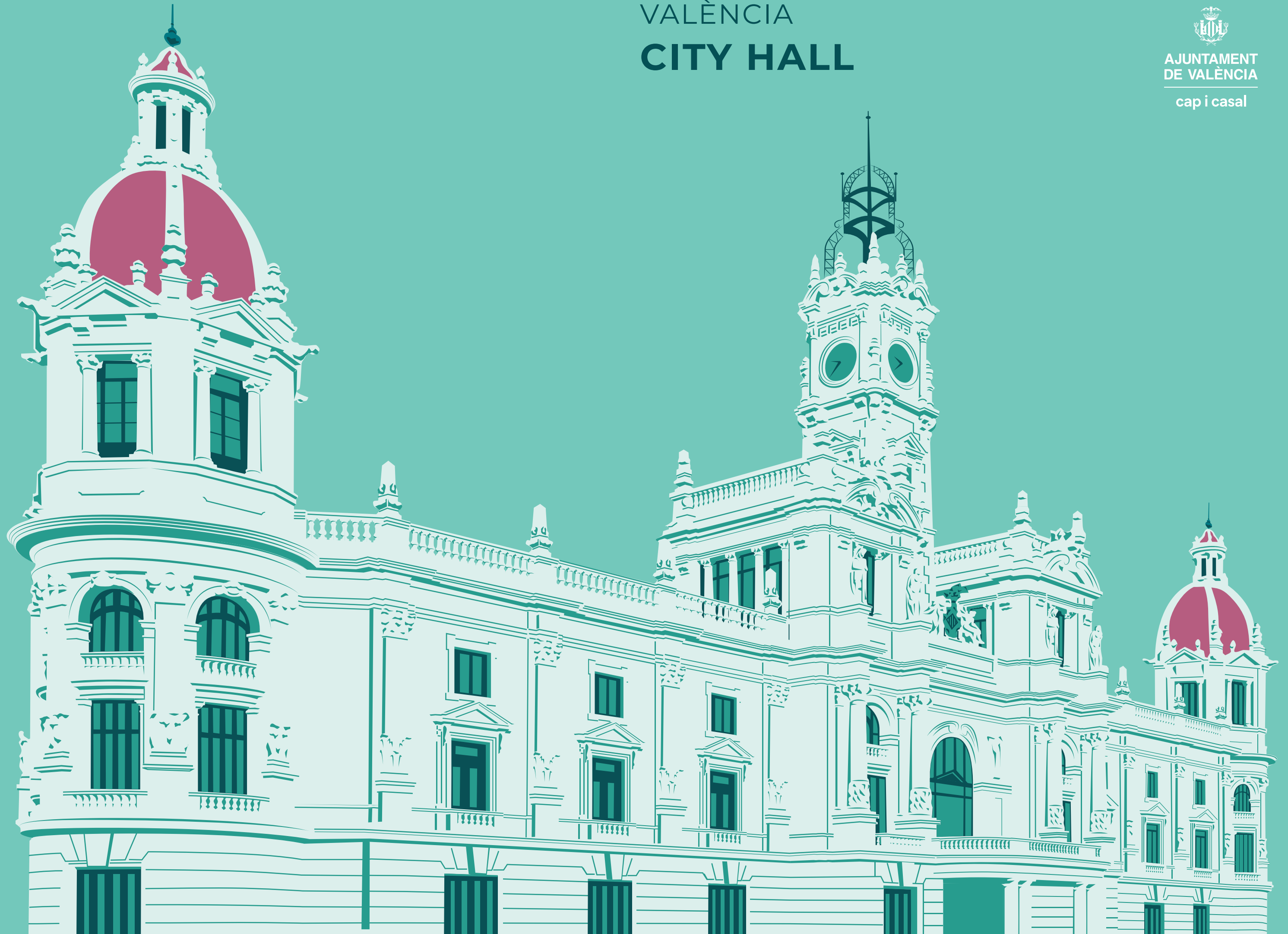

MUNICIPAL HISTORICAL MUSEUM

This museum boasts artworks from the bygone Casa de la Ciutat (House of the City): maps, flags, paintings... It is on the upper floor of the old Church of Santa Rosa de Lima.



EXHIBITION HALL

The lower floor of the former church is used today as a temporary exhibition hall.



A GREAT BUILDING TRACING THE HISTORY OF VALÈNCIA

Inside, the city hall is home to unique spaces where visitors can discover the city's various periods of splendour.

GLASS HALL

This Versailles-style space, decorated with columns, chandeliers and paintings on the ceiling, has a profusion of ornaments.



ENTRANCE STAIRCASE

Imperial marble staircase in neoclassical style, crowned by a modernist skylight.



PLENARY HALL

This chamber was inspired by the Spanish Parliament and the French Assembly, built with the finest materials.



SHELTER

Underground air-raid shelter built during the Civil War.



The city hall is a national historic-artistic monument, officially declared as such in 1962. It covers an area of nearly 6,200 m².

The 88-metre-long facade overlooking the square was added to the building that stood before it in the 1920s.
