Near to where tradition dictates that the event took place, this Valencian ceramic altarpiece commemorates the so-called *Miracle del salser*. In 1359, spice merchant Miquel Garrigues lived in the same street as the Ferrer family. He had a son who suffered from malignant ulcers on the neck, which were cured by another child, Vincent. This is one of the origins of popular devotion in València for his various *miracles* in Valencian, represented by children at the 15 altars in the street during the weekend of his festivity: the Monday after the Second Sunday of Easter.
