

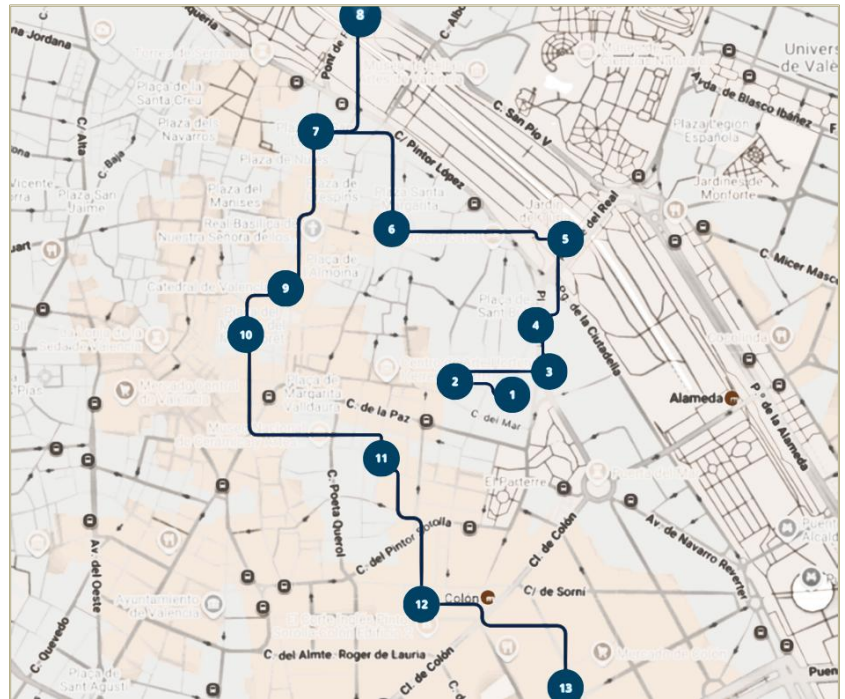
10. MIRACLE DEL MOCADORET SQUARE

Tradition states that, while preaching in València in 1385, on the steps of El Mercat Square, the saint stopped and, deeply moved, said to those listening: "Brothers, right now I see that some of our brothers are asking for immediate help and, if they do not get it, they will die". They asked him where these people were: He replied: "Follow my handkerchief (*mocador* in Valencian) and wherever it goes, you go". And he flung his handkerchief, which was dragged through the air and entered the attic window of a home where these tiles and gravestones are placed. A family was indeed dying of hunger there and were rescued.
