

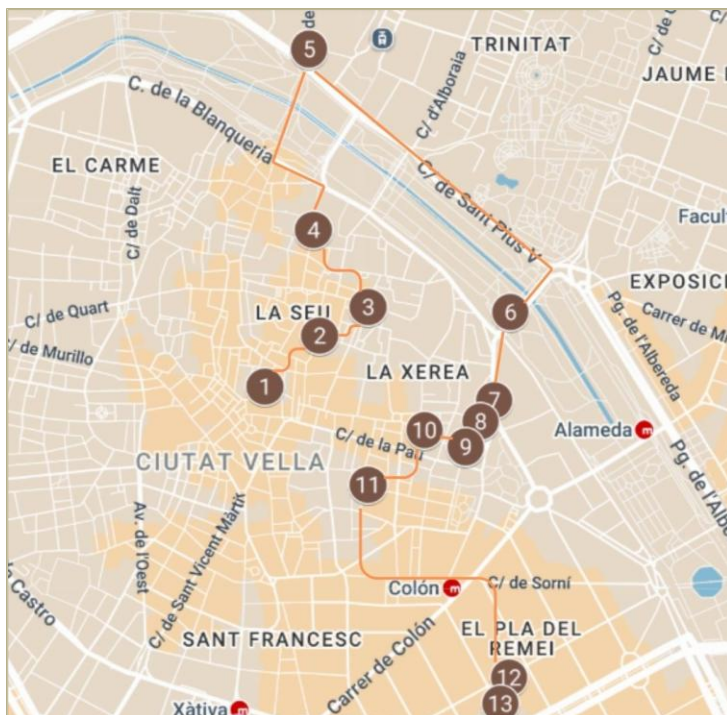

Erected at the expense of Archbishop Saint Juan de Ribera and inaugurated on 8 February 1604. On entering, the first side chapel to the left is dedicated to Saint Vincent Ferrer. Here you will find a large, important canvas by Francisco Ribalto representing Jesus Christ appearing to and miraculously healing the saint in Avignon in 1398; after this, he spent his last 20 years of itinerant preaching around much of Europe. The mural paintings in this chapel by Bartolomeo Matarana are a true visual chronicle of how the city received the saint's relic in October 1601, which is still conserved in this school.

On the walls of the right side of the transept, Matarana also painted three scenes associated with Saint Vincent, much revered by the patriarch: the saint preaching in Perpignan in 1415, his death in Vannes in 1419 and the miraculous healing in València when his relic was received in April 1600.
