



### 13. Traditional residential building

A project by architect Víctor Gosálvez in 1931. The type of building constructed in Poblets Marítims as a summer residence.

The building comprises two homes, one per floor, with: bedrooms, bathroom, kitchen, laundry room and dining room. Given the depth of the plot, the interior rooms have windows opening onto three courtyards.

The main façade on La Reina Street is axially symmetrical to the entrance to the ground floor home.

Modernist in style, it stands out for its elegant relief decoration with geometric and floral motifs that frame the glazed viewpoint. The ironwork was of great ornamental value but is only partially conserved. A balustrade tops the building with a frontispiece decorated with plant motifs framing the date of the building.

The back wall faces El Dr. Lluch Street and is of less ornamental value.
