



53. Traditional residential building

One of the traditional residential buildings in the neighbourhood with two storeys, a central staircase and two homes on each level.

It stands out for its glazed brick wall with ceramic tiles. This is not a characteristic finish in the area although there is another, similar example at 280 Josep Benlliure Street.

The entire wall is clad with glazed brick combining the green base tone with white in the details such as the segmental arch lintels, alternating rows on the upper floor and the entablature. The ceramic tiles under the balconies stand out with a wrought iron structure over brackets with animal symbols.

The openwork cast iron valances to house the blinds contribute to the decoration on the façade, enriching it with a play of lights and shadows when the Mediterranean light shines on the building.

The glazed brick adds colours to the façades, increased by their capacity to reflect light in keeping with the modernist language.
