



6. El Rosari Square

El Rosari Square, Calabuig Square and La Setmana Santa Marinera Square are the most relevant outdoor public spaces in El Canyamelar. Its name comes from the old chapel built by Archbishop Mayoral in 1774. According to the municipal map of 1929-1945, at that time its name was Constitución Square.

Trapezoidal in shape, it is demarcated by El Rosari Street on the longest side and the rest of the perimeter comprises building façades, the most important of which is the church of the same name and El Musical Theatre to the south-east; the other buildings are residential.

L'Església del Rosari, L'Alegria and L'Abadia del Rosari all converge in the square; access to the square from this last street is the most attractive thanks to the foreshortened views of the church and bell tower.
