Construction began in 1595 and was completed three years later to mark the marriage between Phillip III and Queen Margaret. It was built with materials, stones and even headstones with inscriptions from the nearby Convent of Preachers. Two *casalicios* (structures housing a statue) dedicated to the two Saint Vincents –Martyr and Ferrer– adorn the bridge. The current statues replaced the old 17th-century versions in 1946, which disappeared during the Civil War. The statue of Saint Vincent Ferrer was by Ignacio Pinazo.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Address: Pont del Real.

ACCESSIBILITY

Access: accessible area with ramps and dropped curbs.

Parking: parking spaces for people with reduced mobility at 8 Sant Donís Street, 1 La Ciutadella Promenade and 6 Ximénez de Sandoval Street.
