

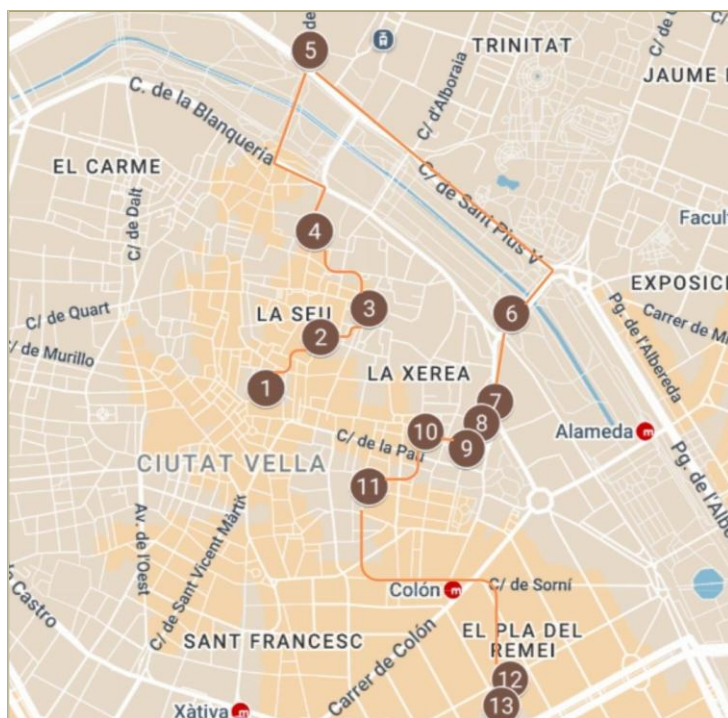
8. STATUE OF SAINT VINCENT FERRER IN TETUAN SQUARE

This statue was erected in 1960. Its pedestal bears the inscription: '*Valencia agradecida a la protección dispensada a la ciudad por San Vicente Ferrer en el año 1677 [amenazada por una grave epidemia]. Emplazamiento y restauración en 1960*' (València grateful for the protection bestowed upon the city by Saint Vincent Ferrer in 1677 [threatened by a serious epidemic]. Installed and restored in 1960).

The sculpture originally stood at the gateway to the city (today Sant Agustí Square) next to another of Saint Vincent Martyr, at the entrance to the wall. It was made of marble and sandstone by Carlos J Cloostermans in 1835.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ACCESSIBILITY

Access: accessible square with ramps and dropped curbs.
