





Monthly average temperature. 2011






Climate diagram. 2011





Population aged 10 and over in familiar dwellings according to level of completed studies. 2001
























Preschool Education. Course 2011/12







Percentage of votes to candidature regarding valid votes






Evolution Votes Main Candidatures
