Monthly average temperature. 2011



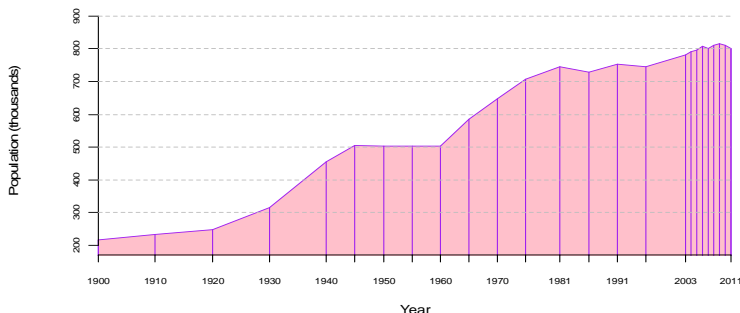

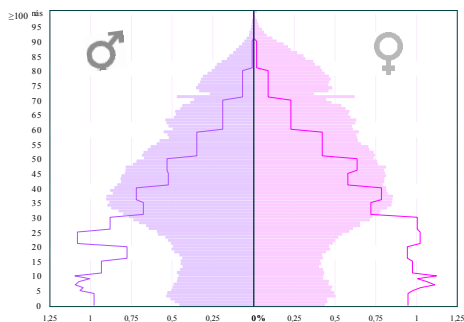

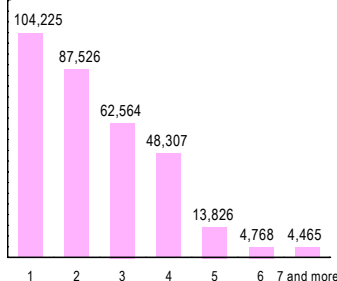

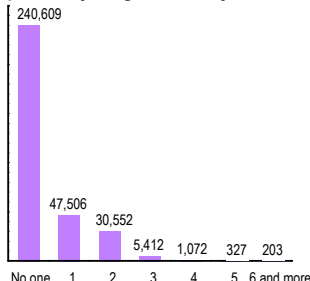
Population Pyramid. Comparison 1900 and 2012

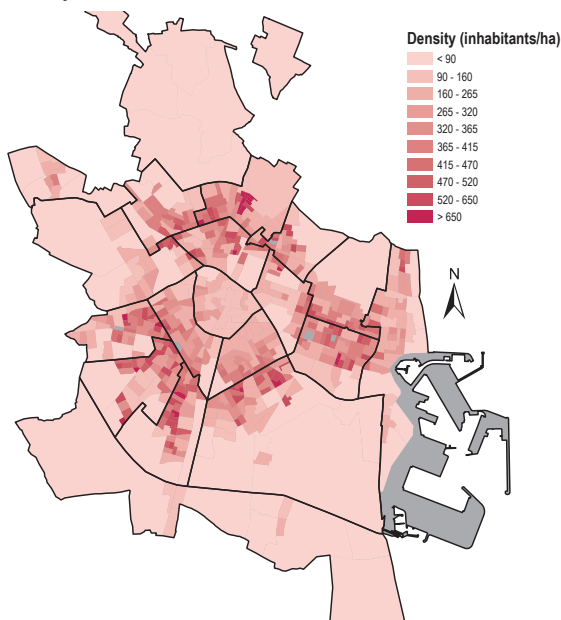

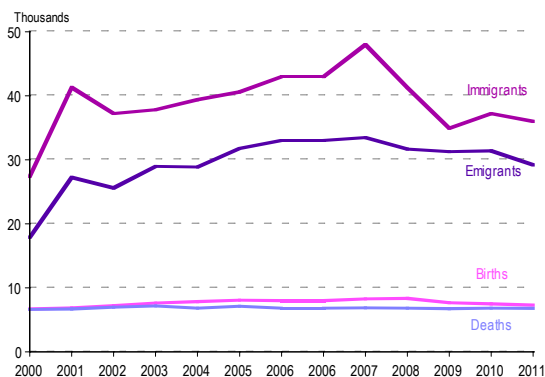

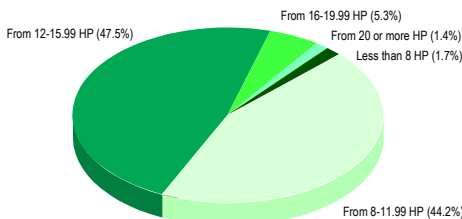

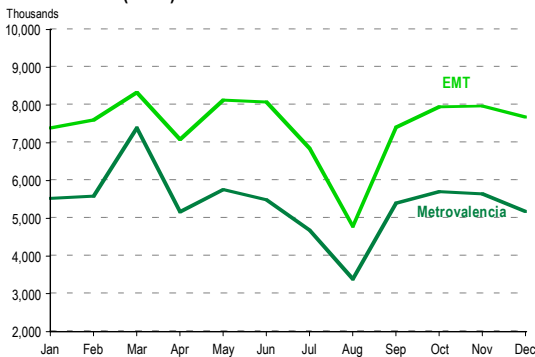
Cars according to power. 2012

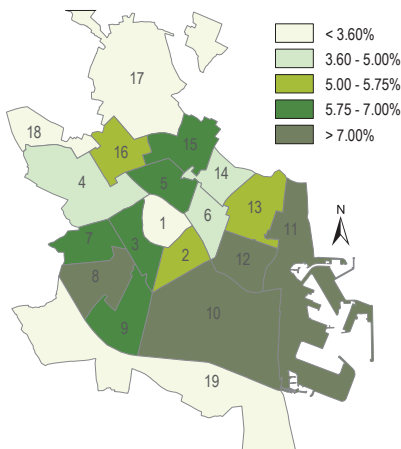

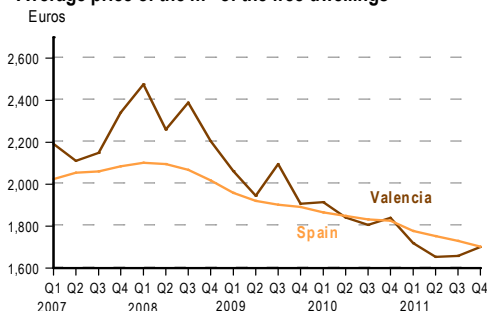

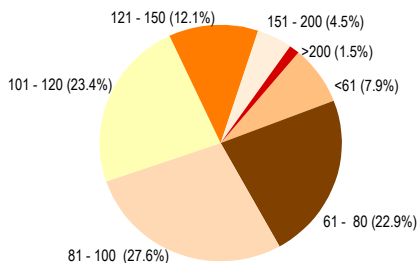

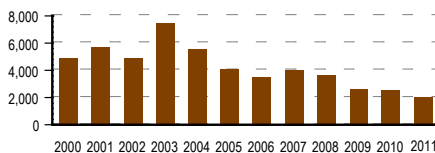

First occupation licences of dwellings



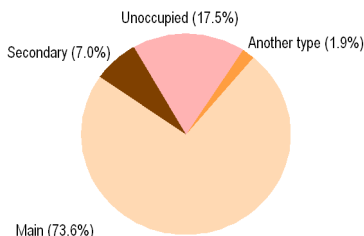

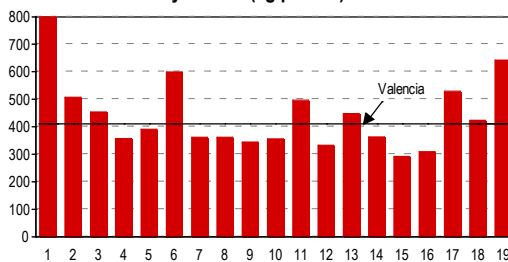

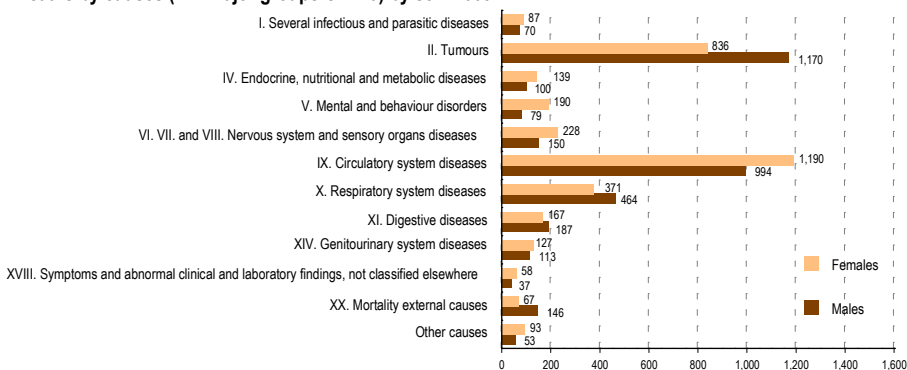
Waste collection by district (kg/person)

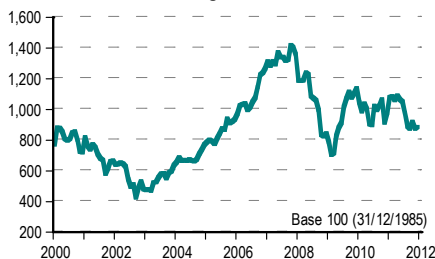

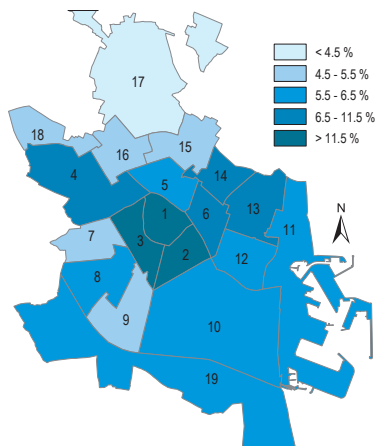

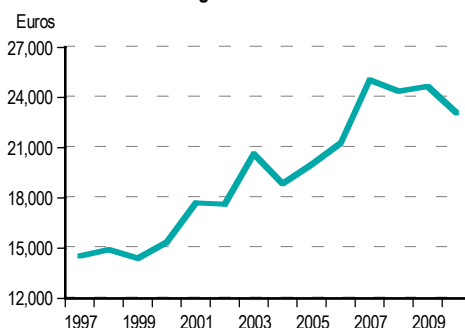
Shops and services per 100 inhabitants. 2012

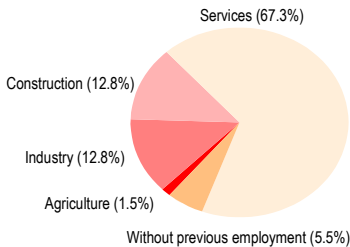
Evolution of the average taxable base

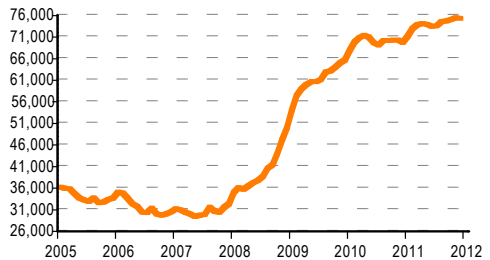

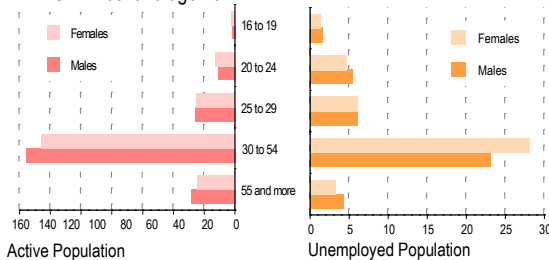

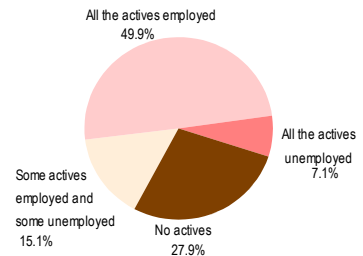
Active and unemployed population

EAPS. Annual average 2011



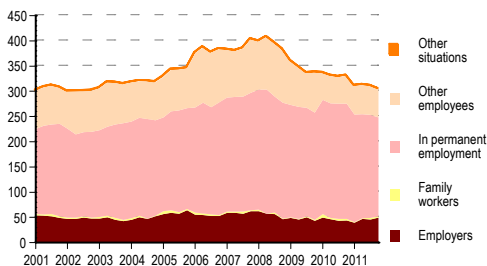
Households by activity of their members.

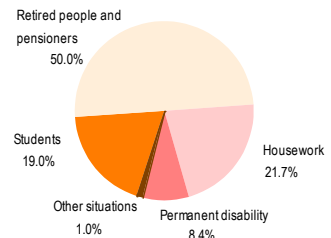

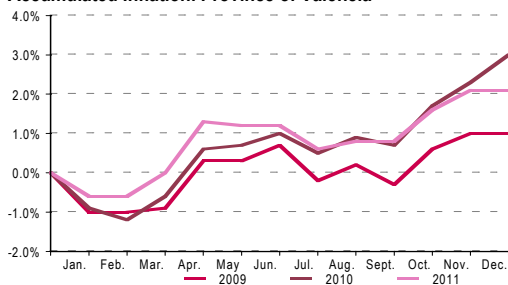

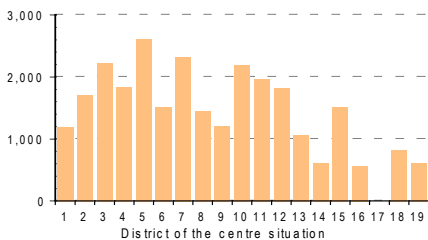

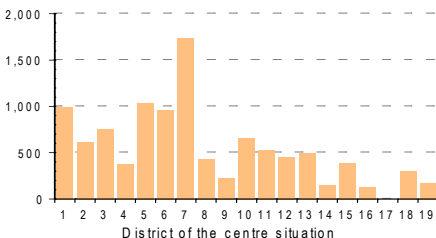

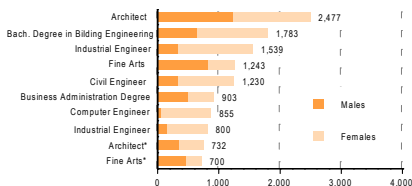

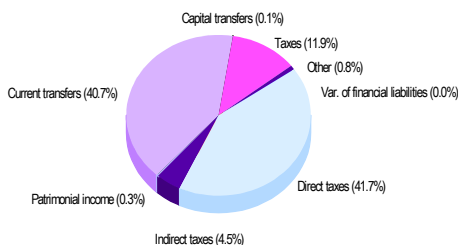

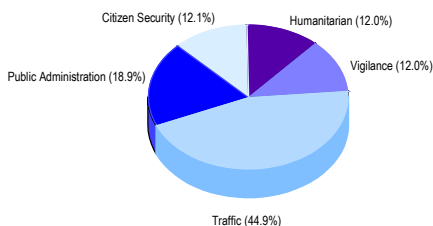

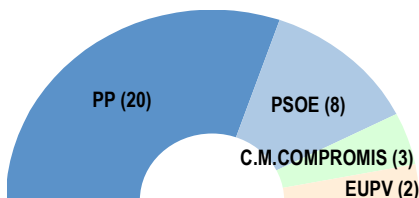

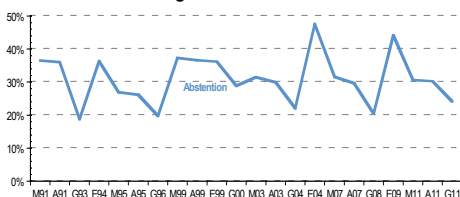

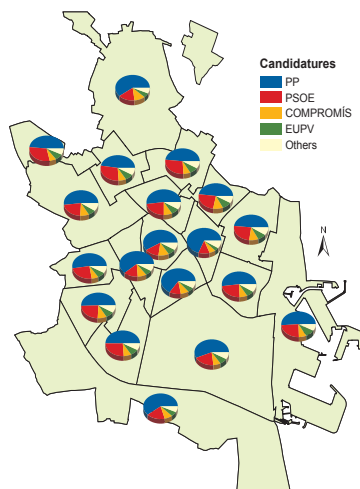
Evolution Votes Main Candidatures
