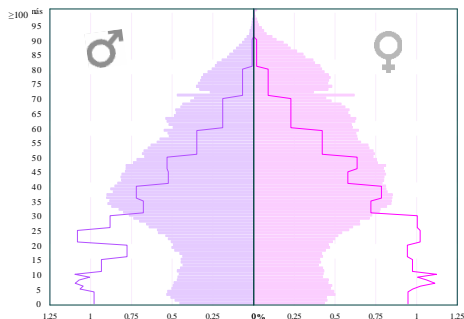

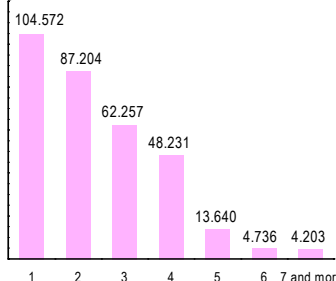

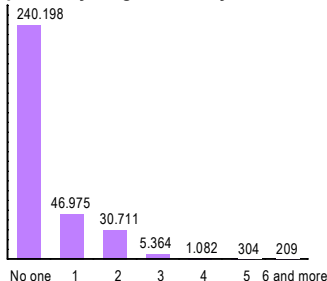
Population Pyramid, Comparison 1900 and 2012



Family registry sheets by number of persons



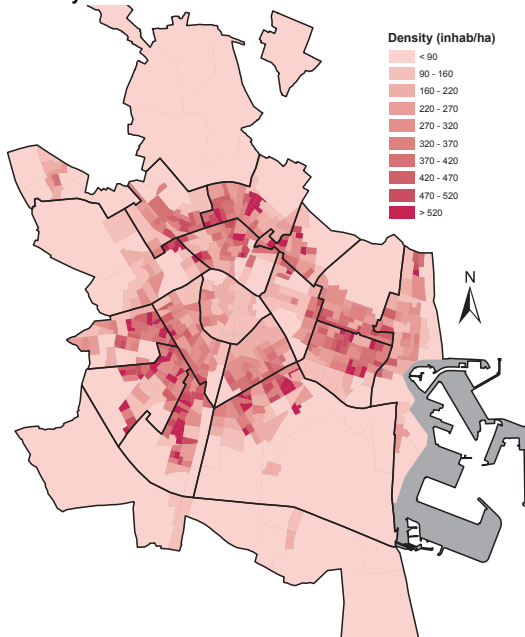
Family registry sheets by number of persons younger than 18 years old

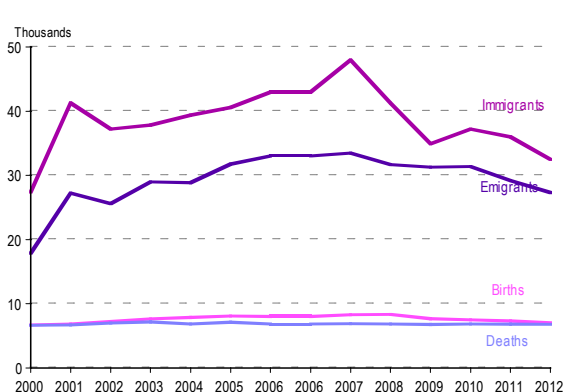

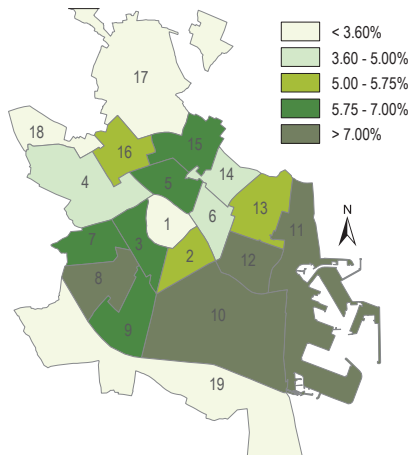

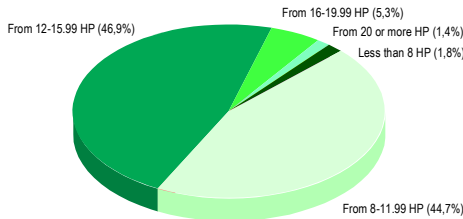

Number of individual cars. 2013



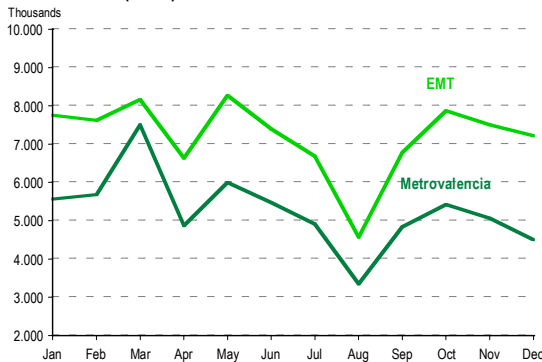
Cars according to power. 2013

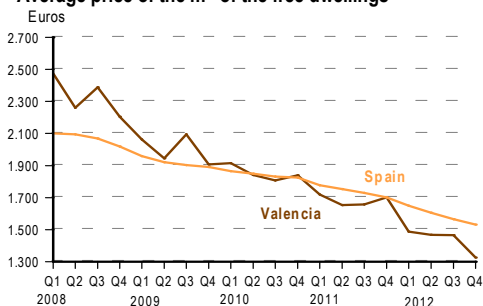

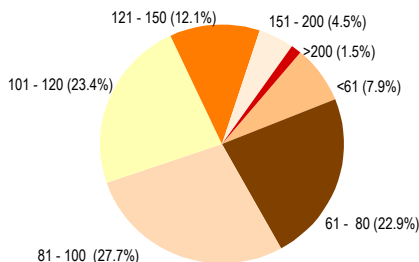

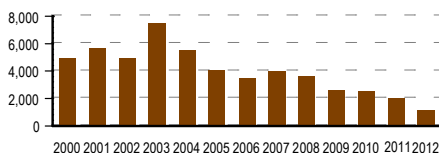

First occupation licences of dwellings



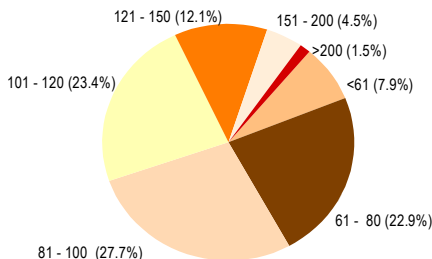

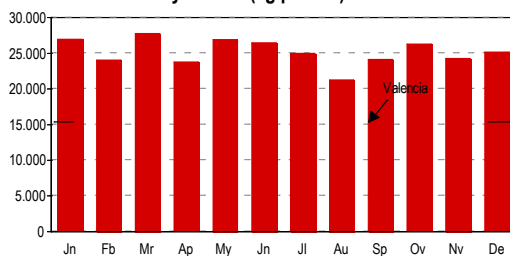

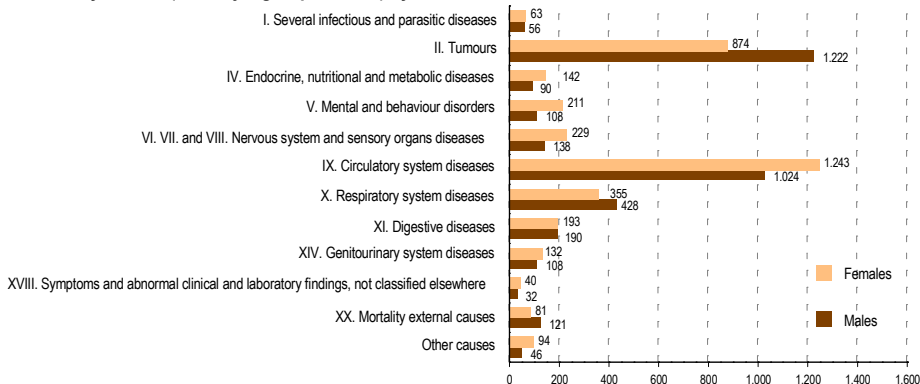
Waste collection by district (kg/person)

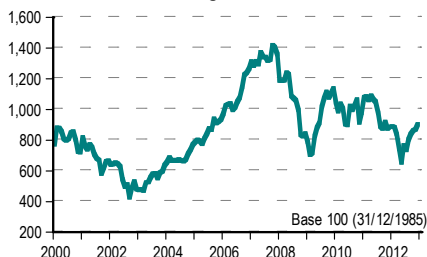

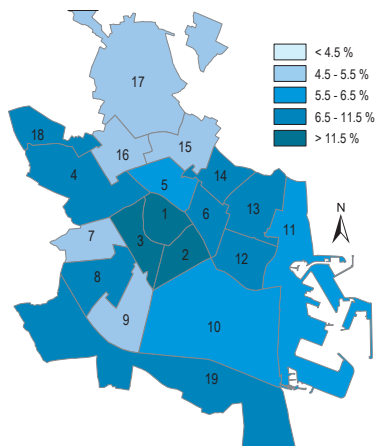

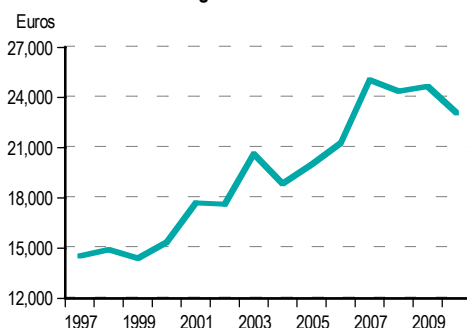
Shops and services per 100 inhabitants. 2012

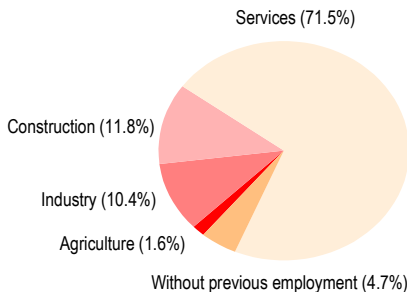
Evolution of the average taxable base

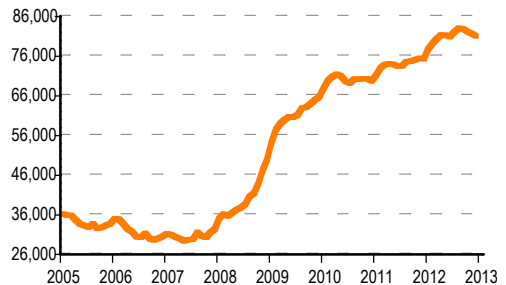

Evolution of the unemployment



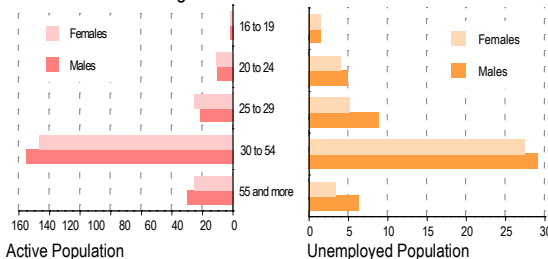

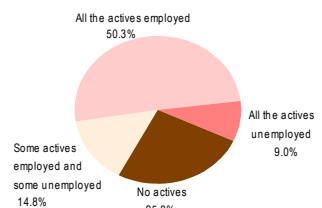

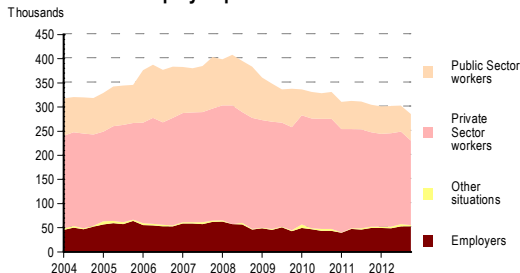
Active and unemployed population EAPS. Annual average 2012



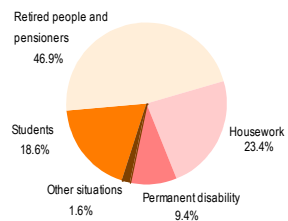
Households by activity of their members. EAPS. Annual average 2012

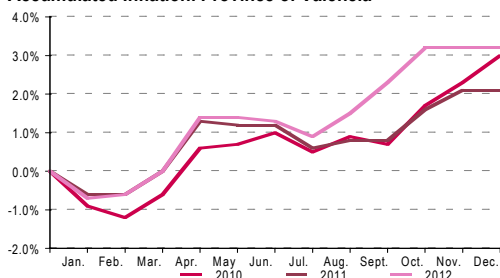

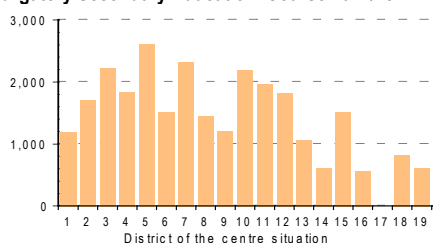

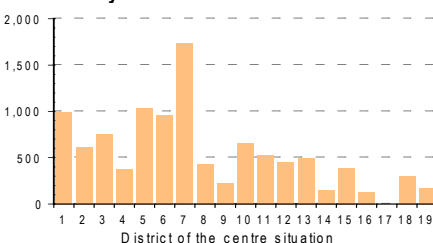

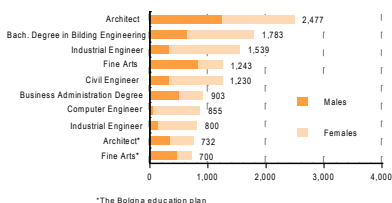

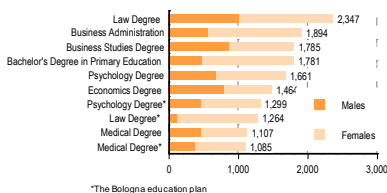

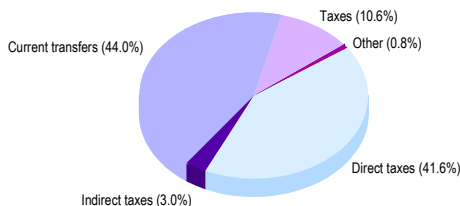

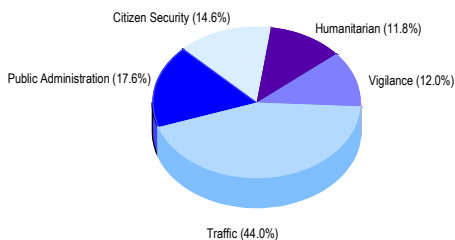

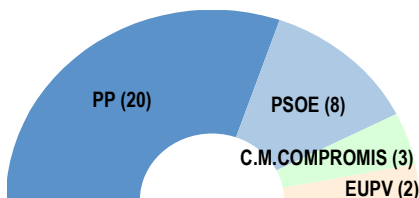

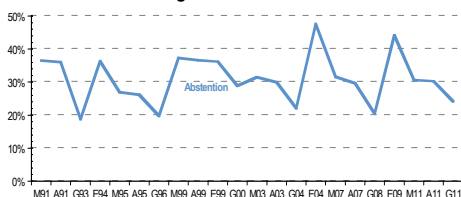

Percentage of votes to candidatures regarding valid votes

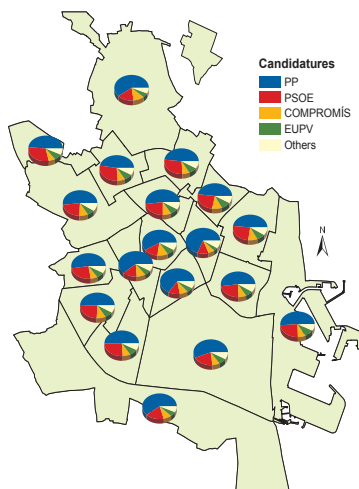
Evolution Votes Main Candidatures
