





#### Monthly average temperature. 2013






#### Climate diagram. 2013





#### Population Pyramid. Comparison 1900 and 2014






#### Immigrants according to the origin. 2013




#### Average price of the m<sup>2</sup> of the free dwellings







#### Evolution of the average taxable base


























Percentage of votes to candidatures regarding valid votes
