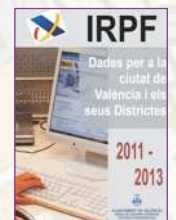

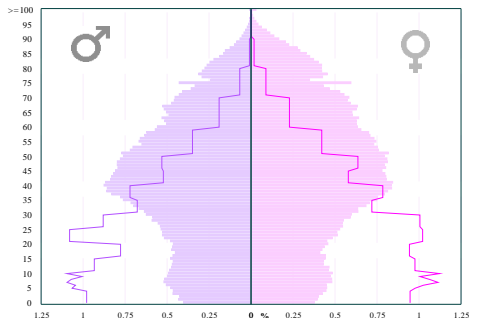

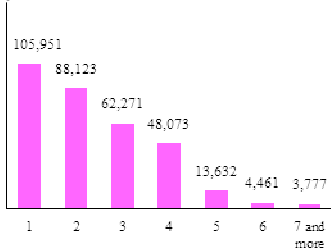

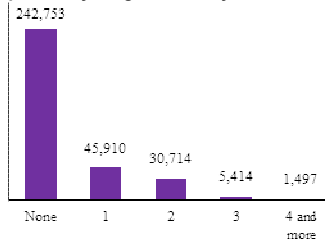
Population Pyramid. Comparison 1900 and 2016



Family registry sheets by number of persons



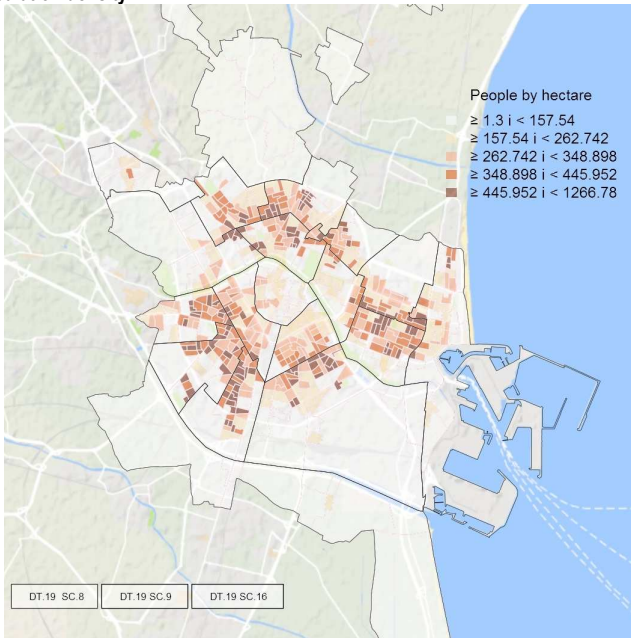

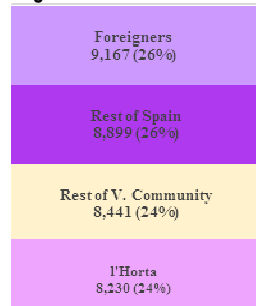

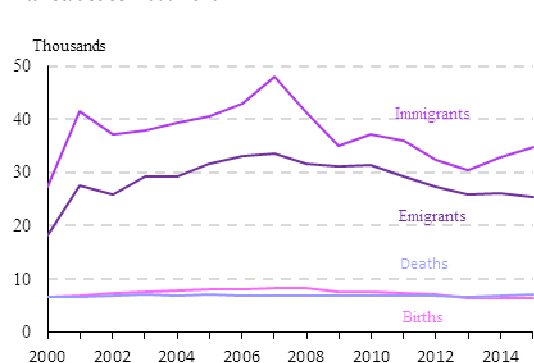

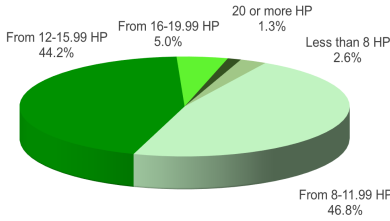

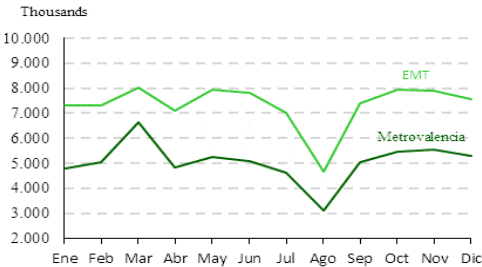

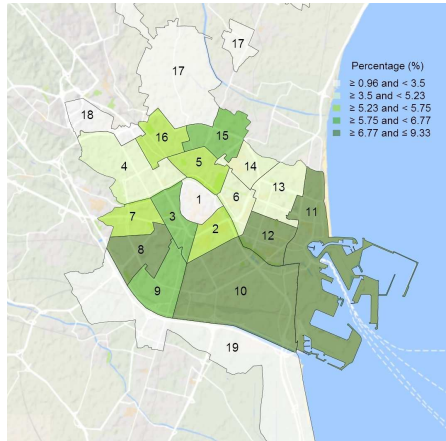

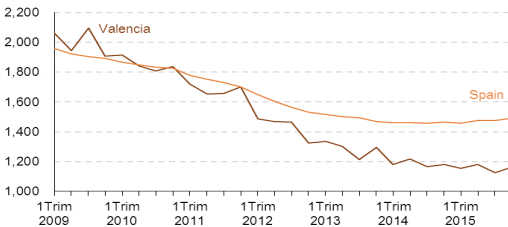

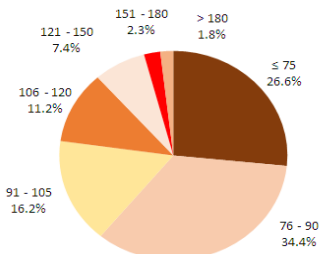

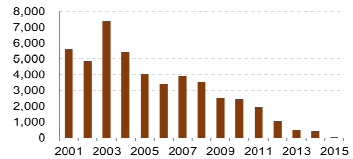

First occupation licences of dwellings



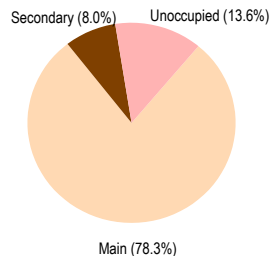

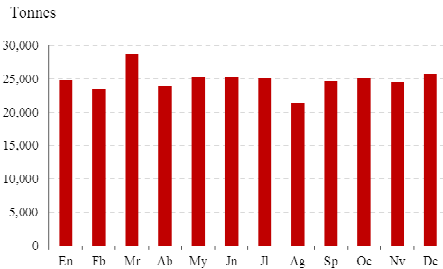

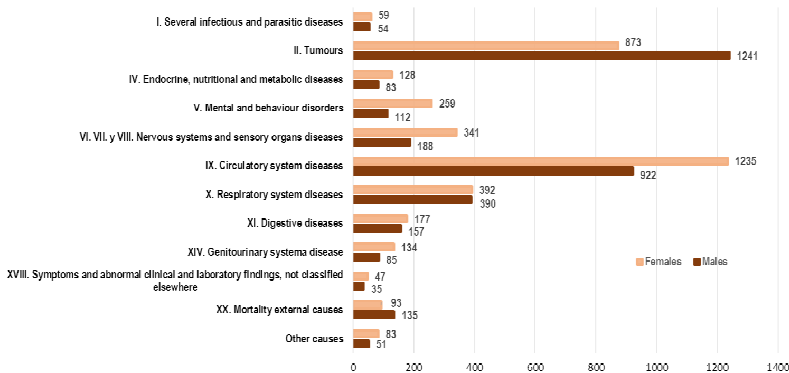
Waste collection by month, 2015

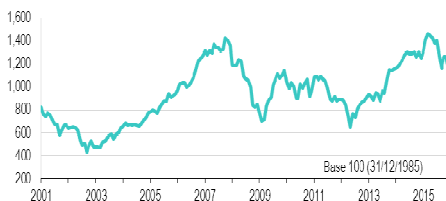

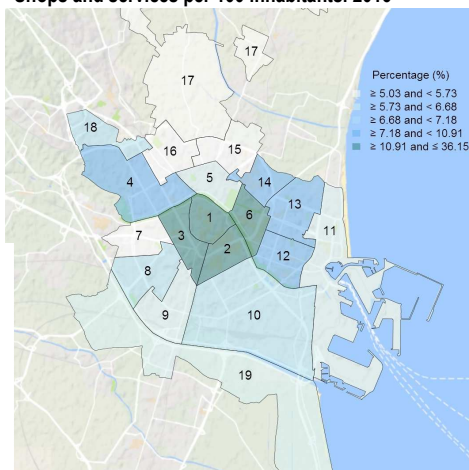

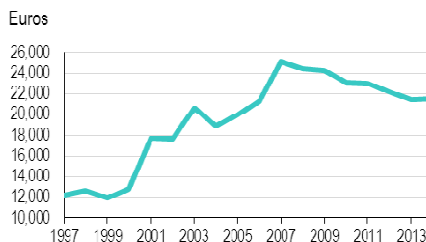

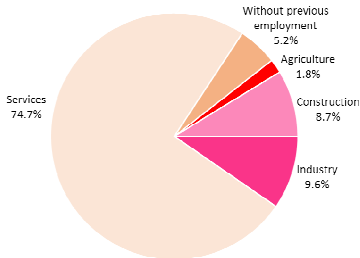
Evolution of the average taxable base



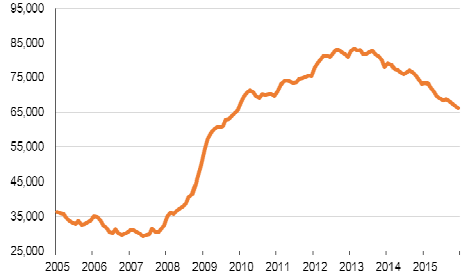

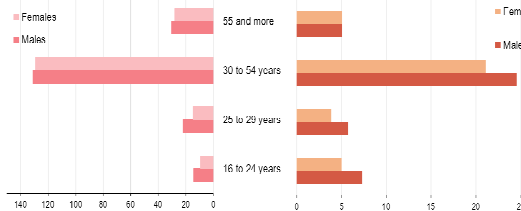

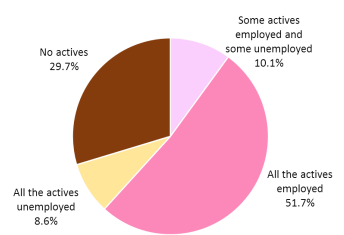
Active and unemployed population

Households by activity of their members.

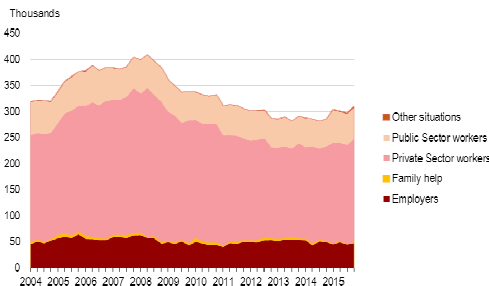

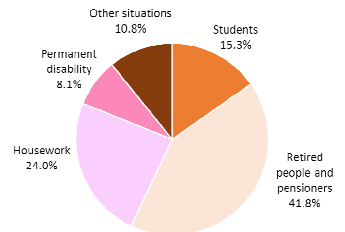

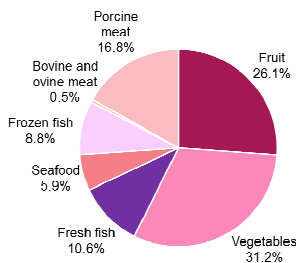

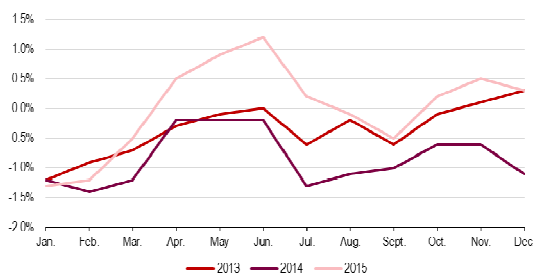

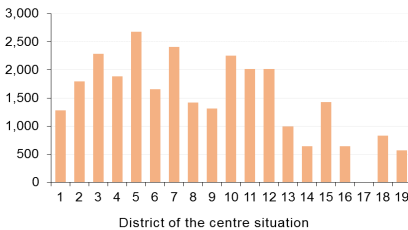
Preschool Education. Course 2015/16



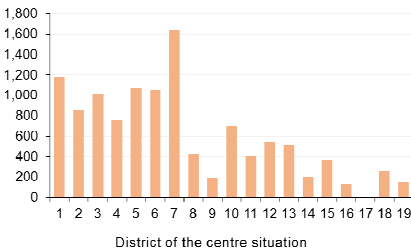
Primary Education. Course 2015/16

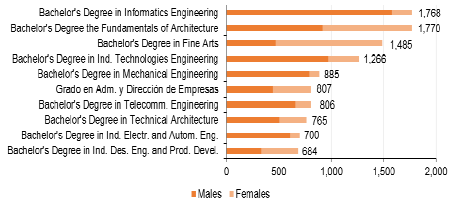

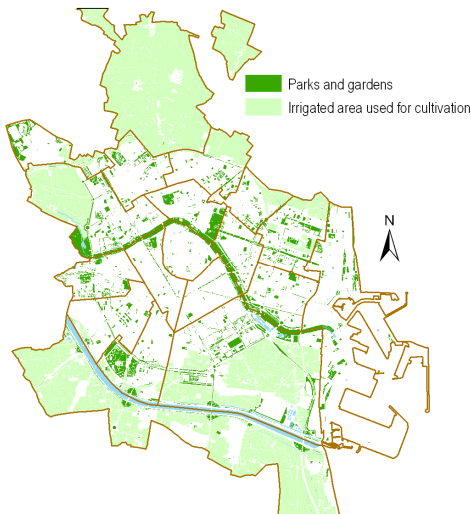

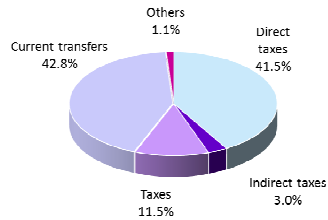

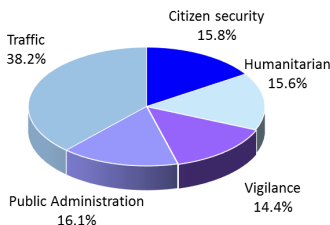

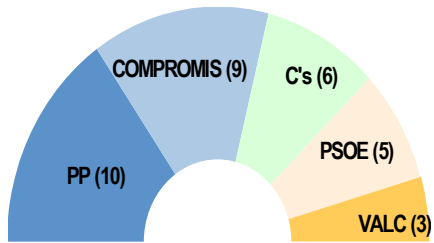

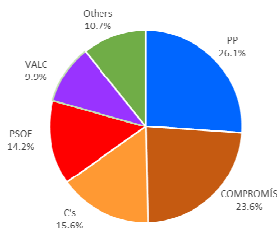

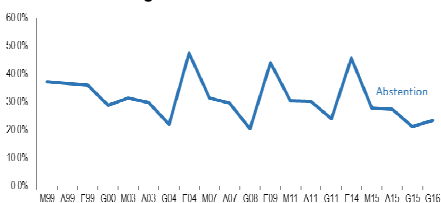

Percentage of votes regarding votes to candidatures

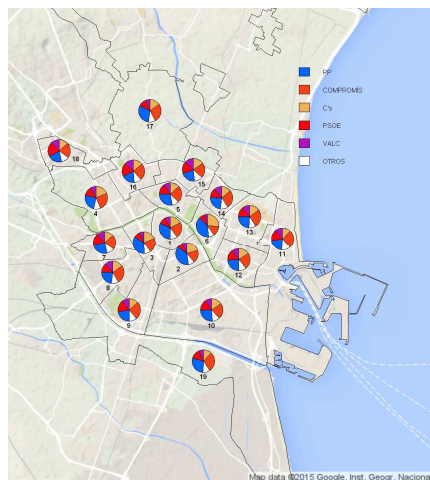
Municipal Elections 2015
