## Monthly average temperature. 2017



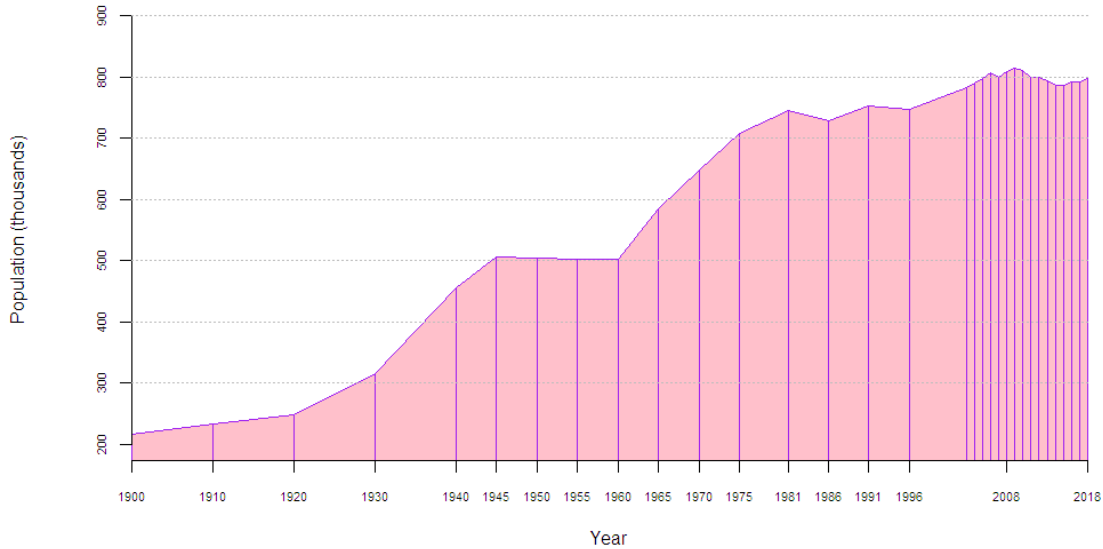

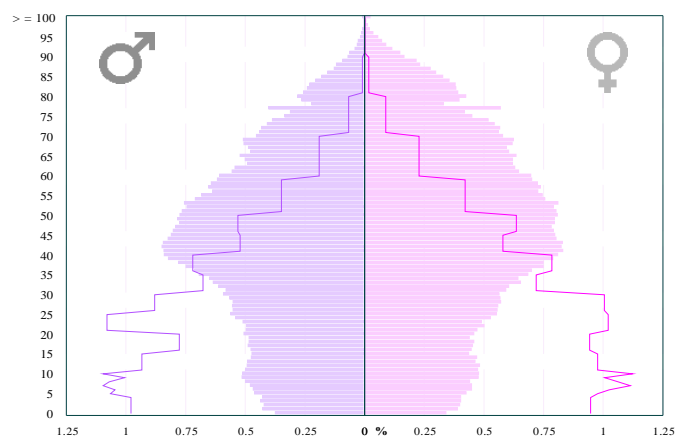

### Population Pyramid. Comparison 1900 and 2018



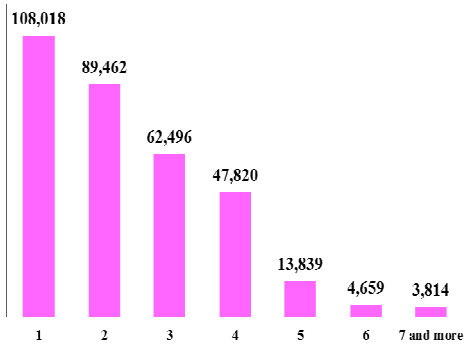

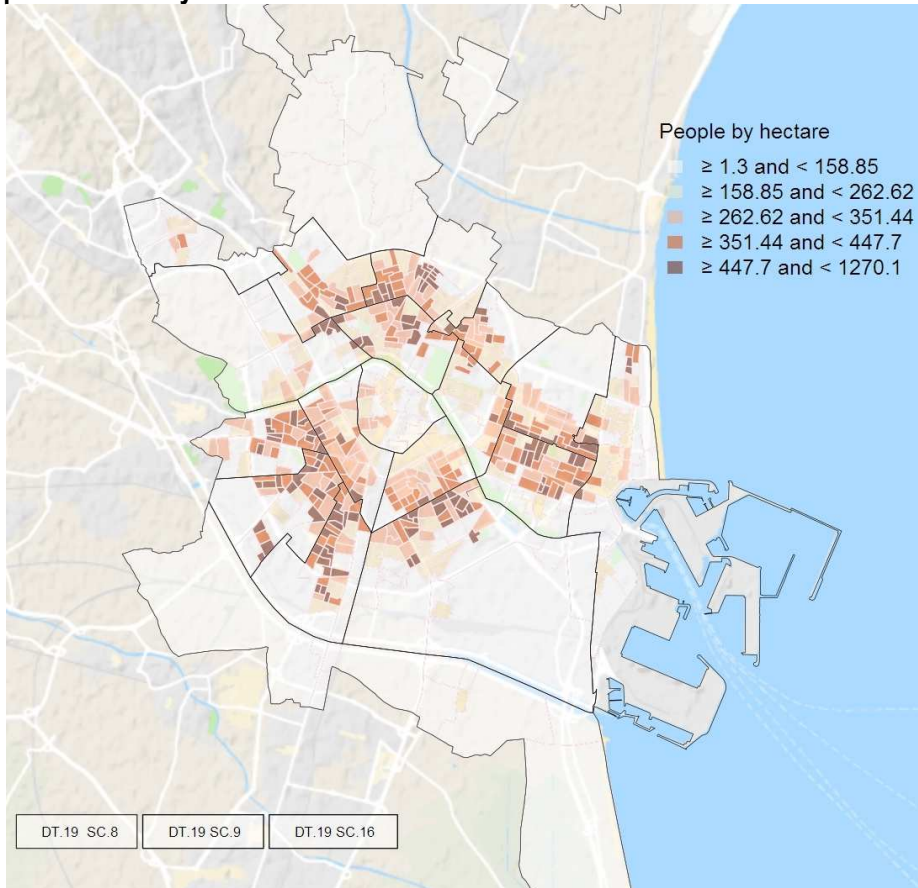

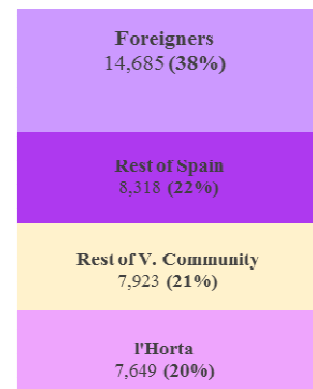

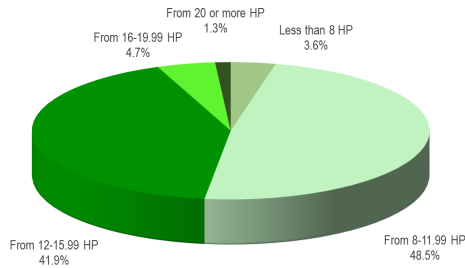

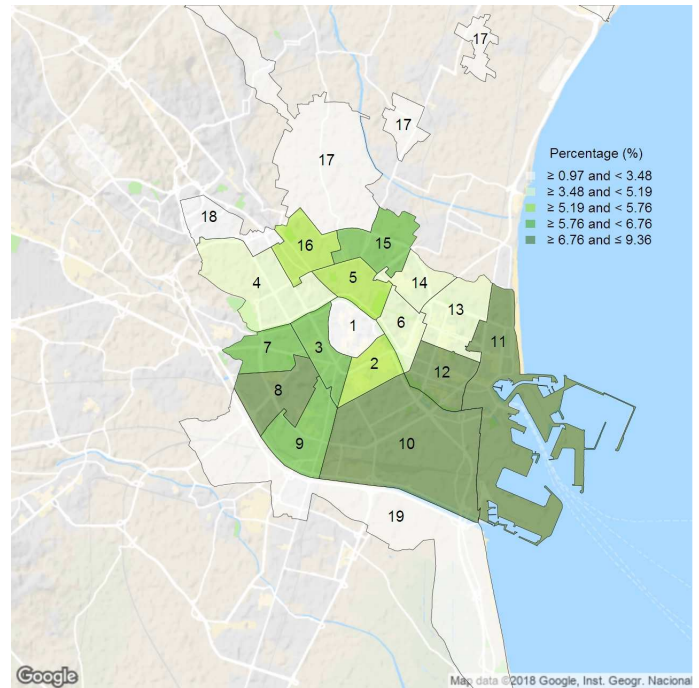

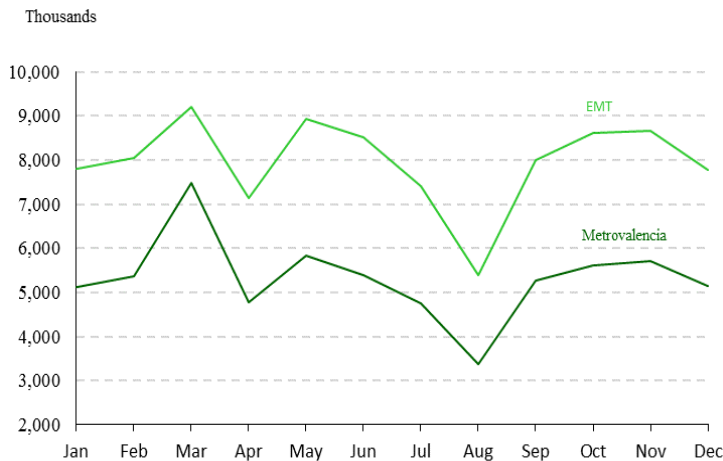

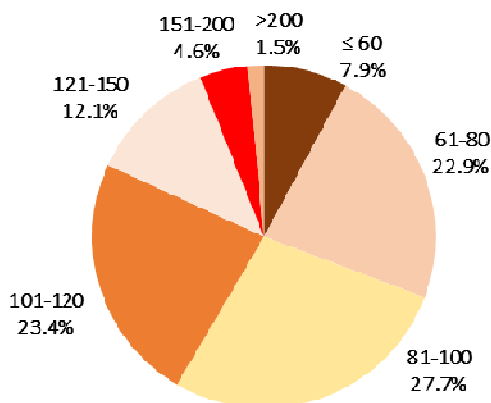

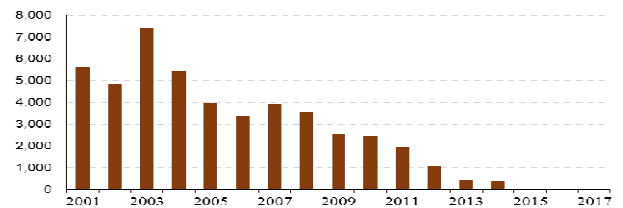

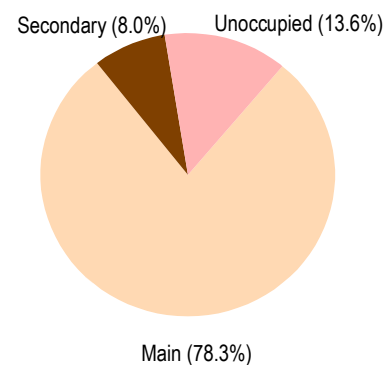

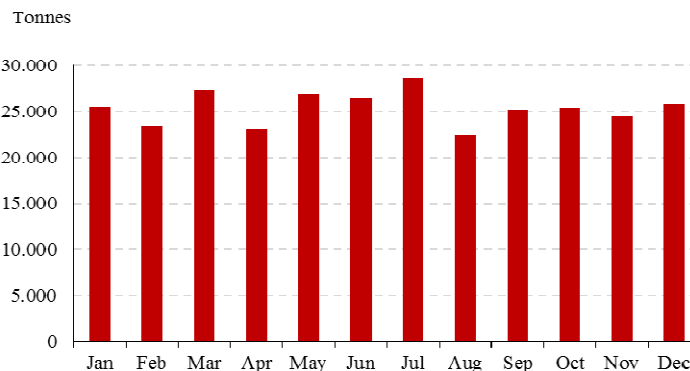

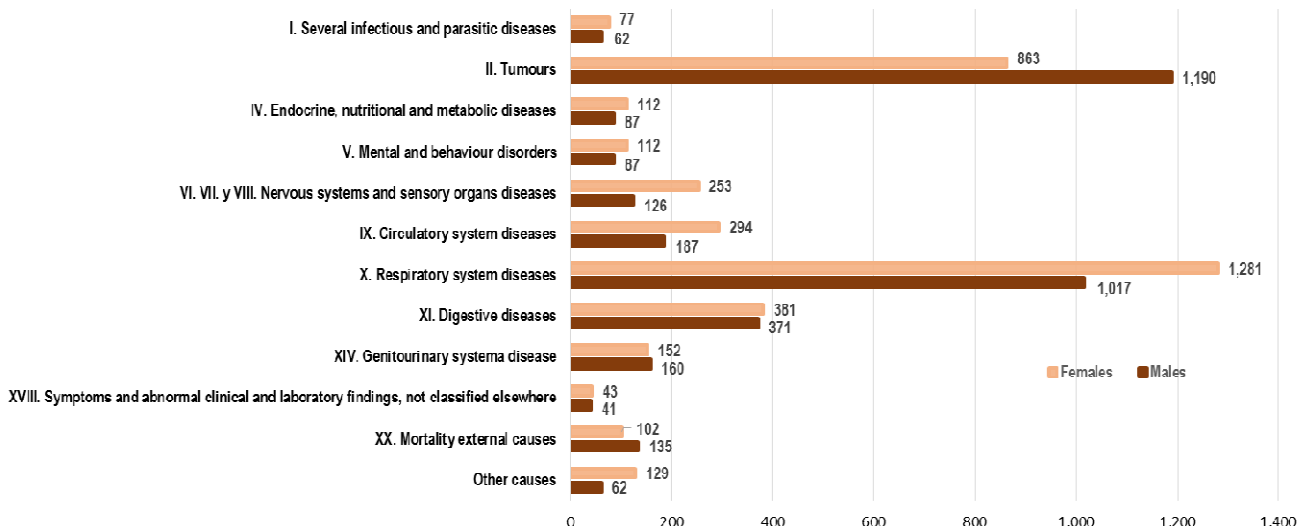
### Waste collection by month. 2017

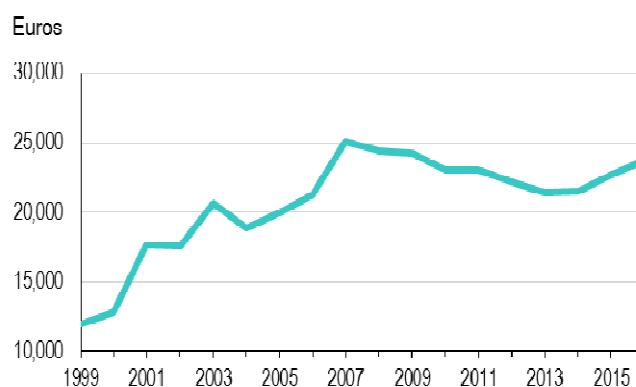

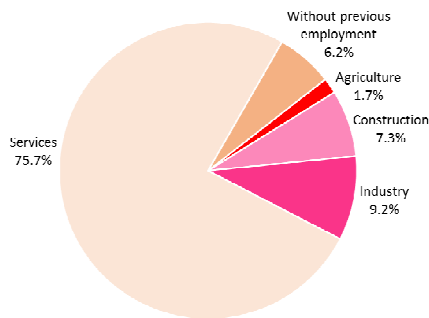

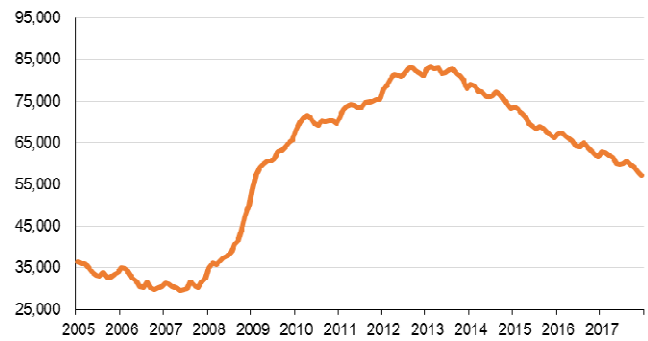

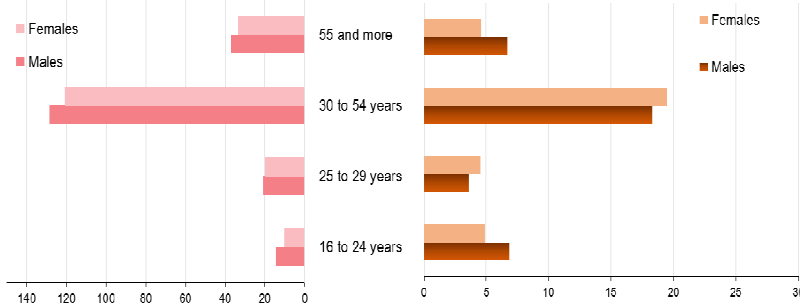

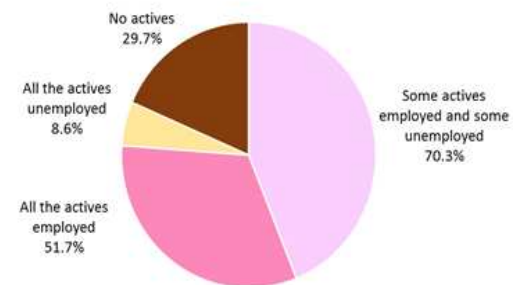

EAPS. Annual average 2017



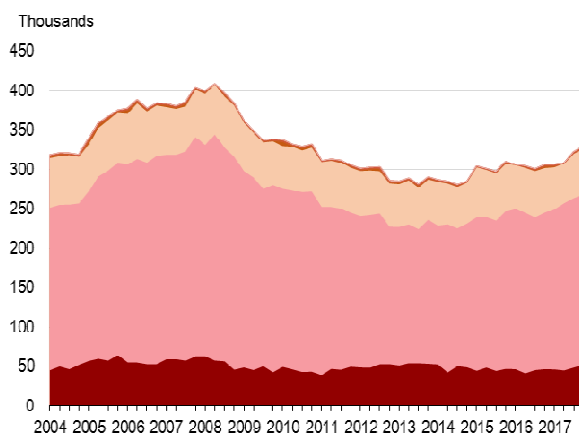

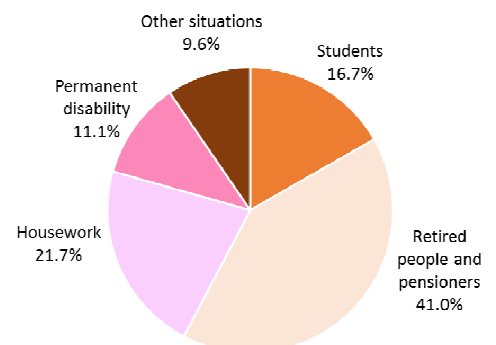

### Accumulated Inflation. Province of Valencia

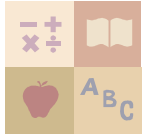

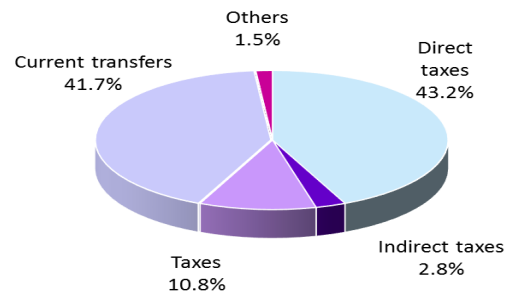

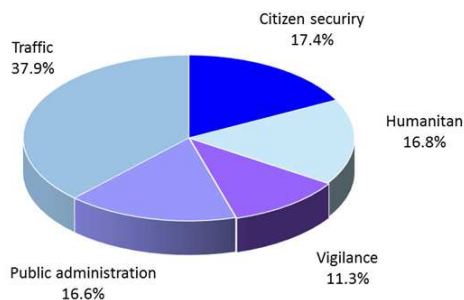

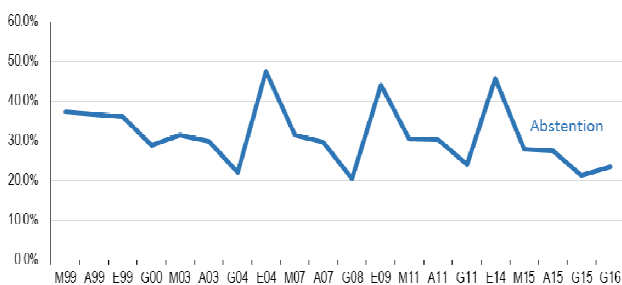
