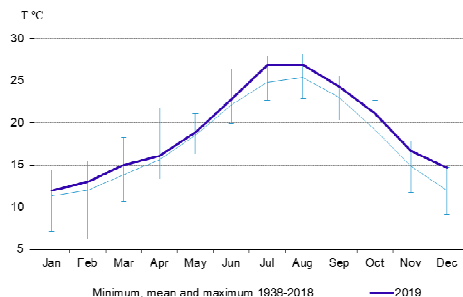

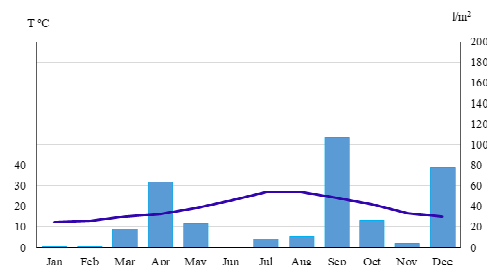

Monthly average temperature. 2019



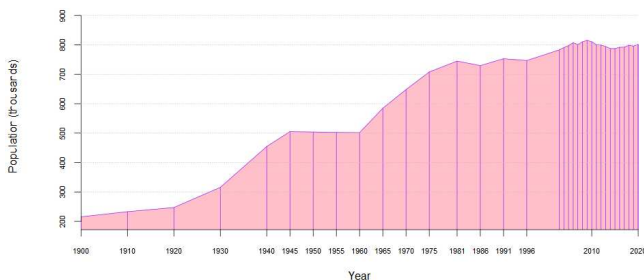
Climate diagram. 2019

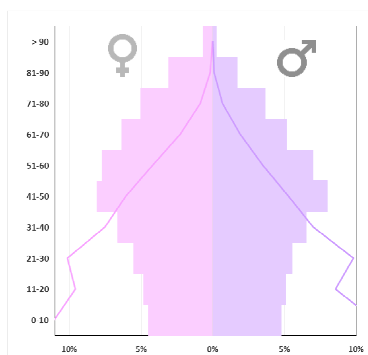

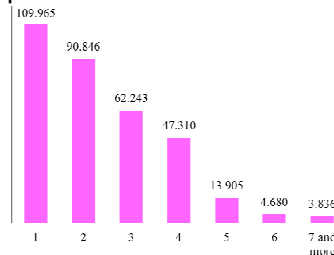

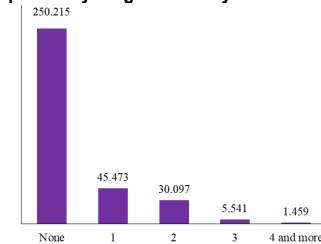
Population Pyramid. Comparison 1900 and 2020



Family registry sheets by number of persons



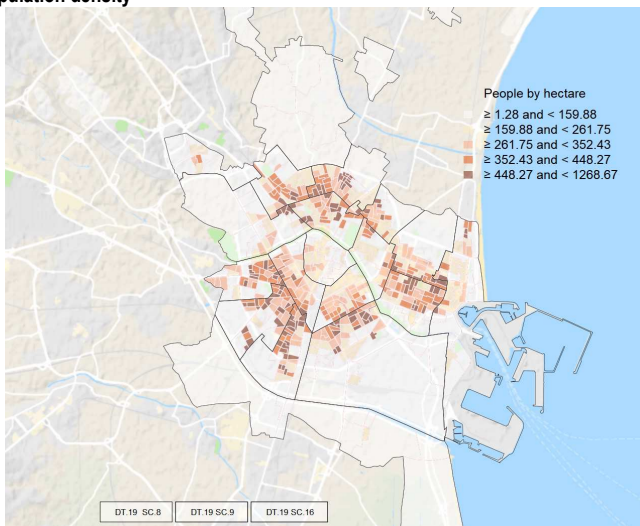

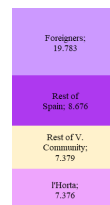

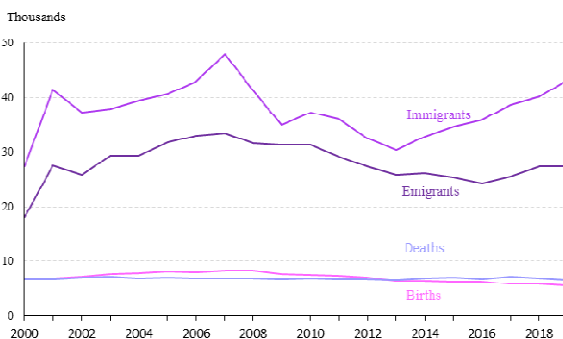

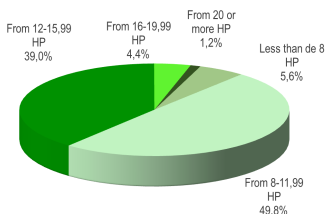

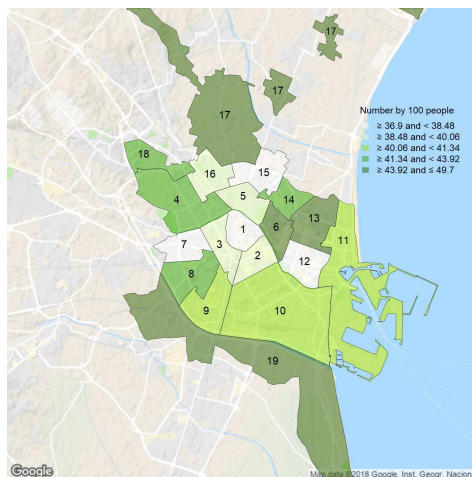
Cars according to power. 2020

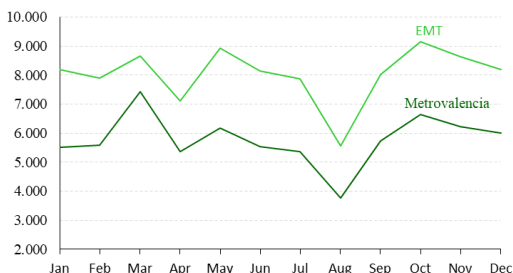

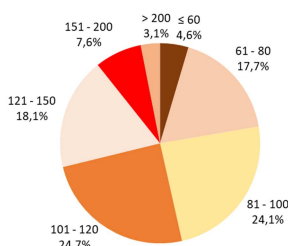

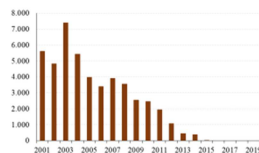

First occupation licences of dwellings



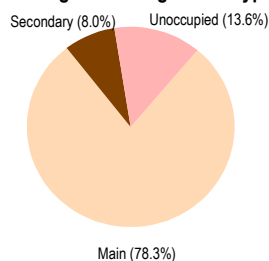

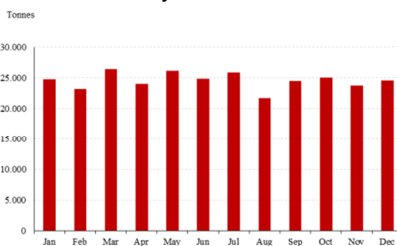

Waste collection by month. 2019

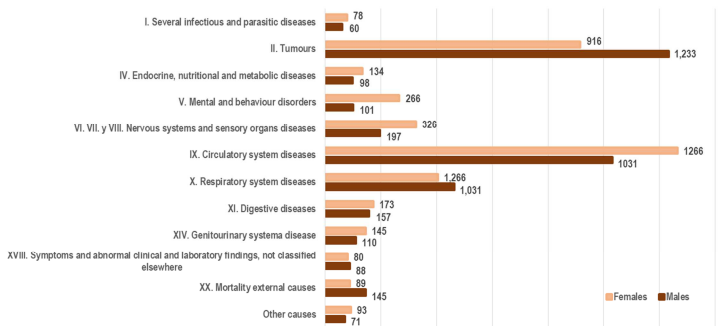

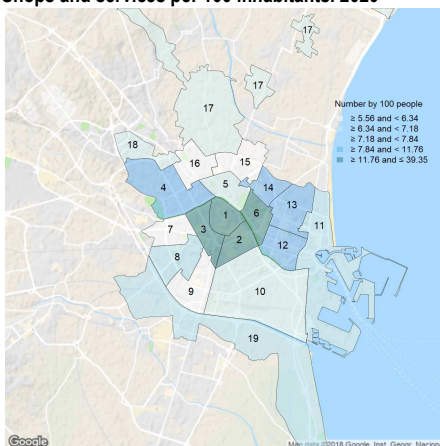

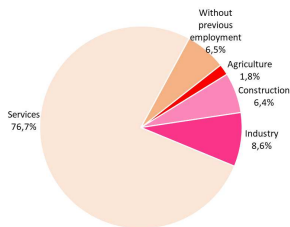
Evolution of the average taxable base 1998-2018



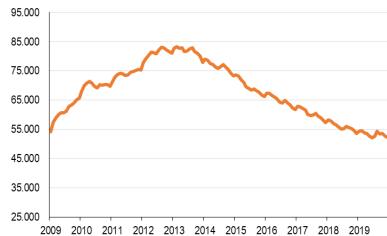

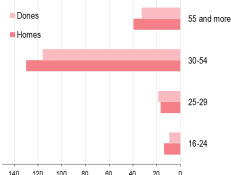

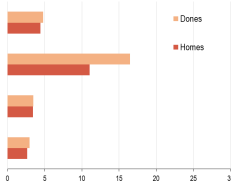

Active and unemployed population EAPS. Annual average 2019

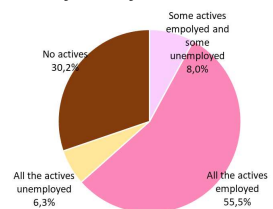
Active Population



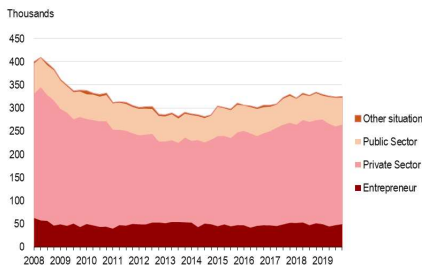
Unemployed Population



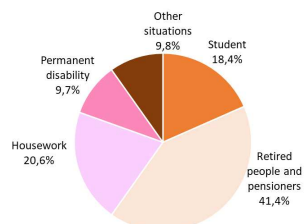
Households by activity of their members.

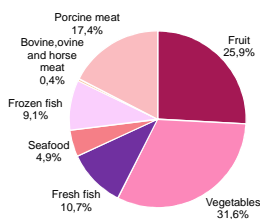

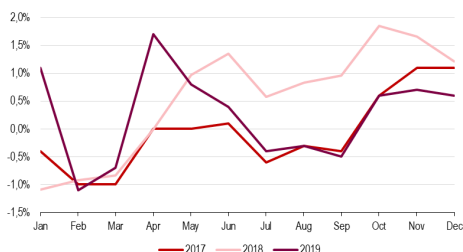

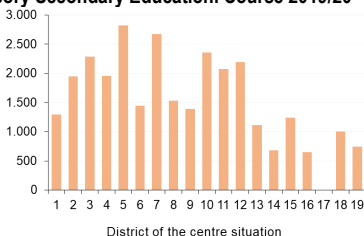
Preschool Education. Course 2019/20



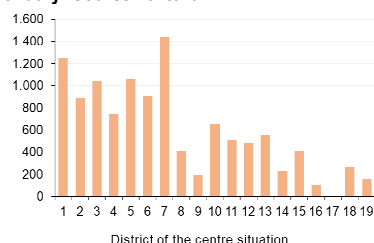
Primary Education. Course 2019/20



Compulsory Secondary Education. Course 2019/20



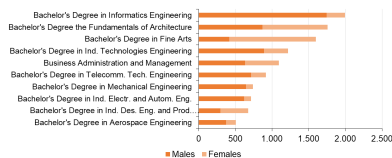

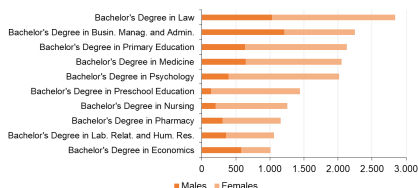

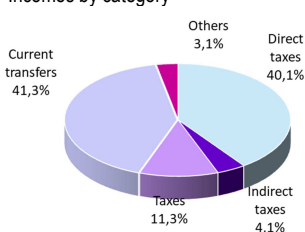

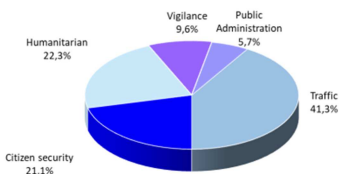

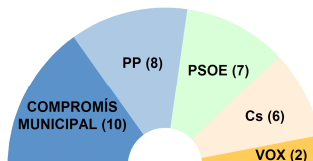

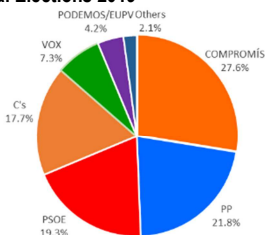

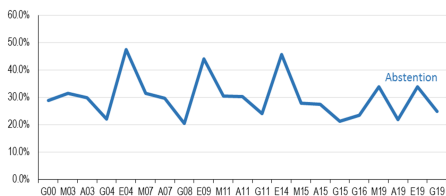

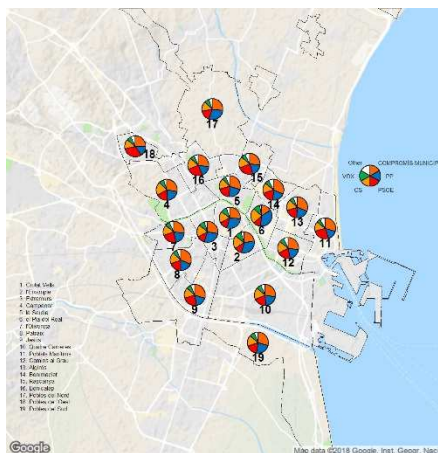
Municipal Elections 2019
