## Monthly average temperature. 2022

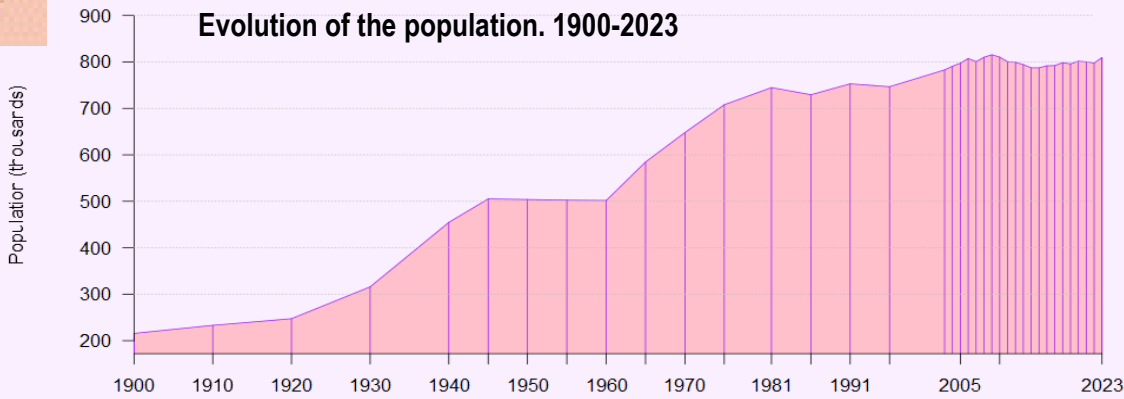

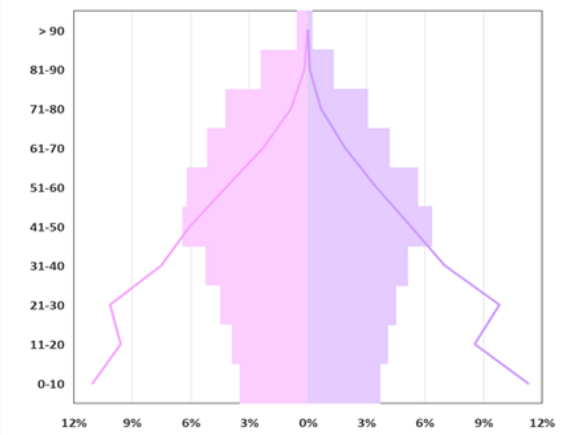

### Population pyramid. Comparison 1900 vs. 2023



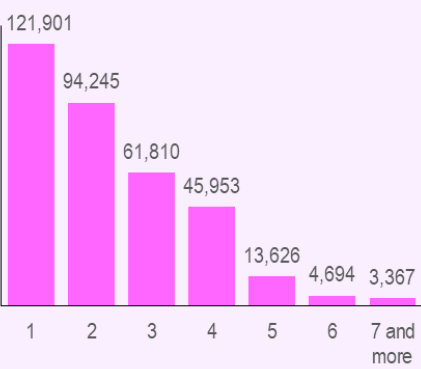

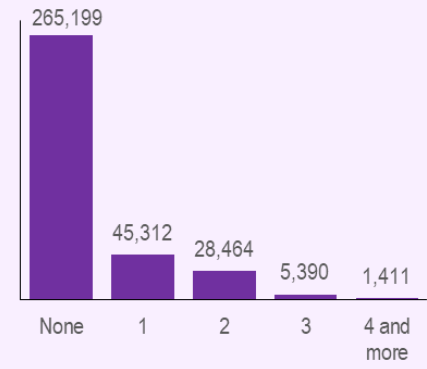

Family registry sheets by number of persons. 2023



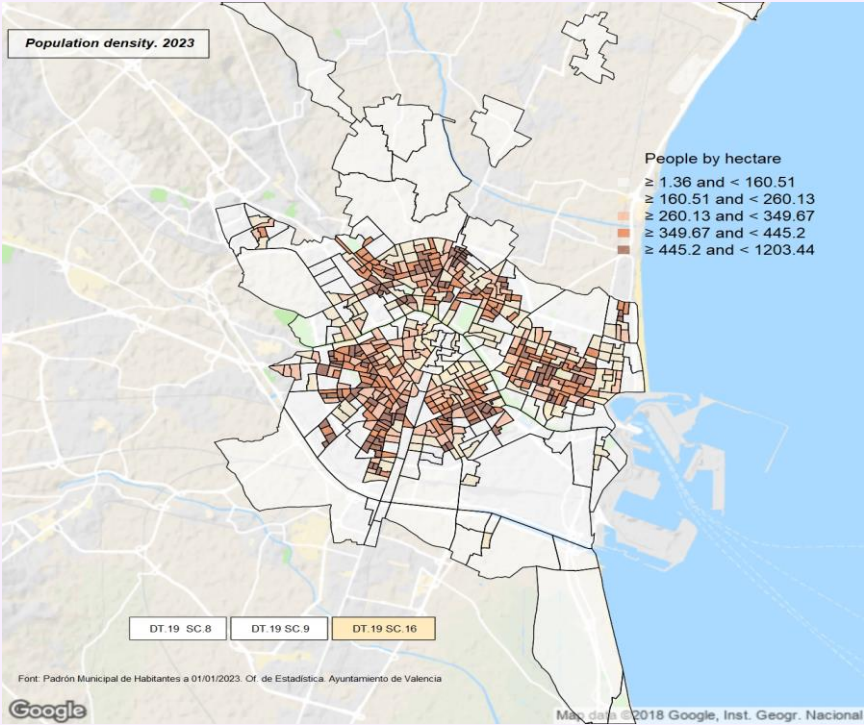

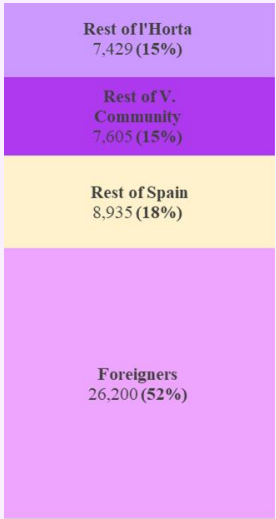

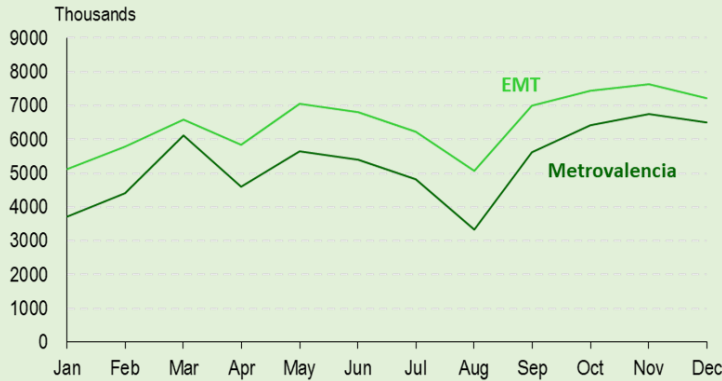

## Passengers of the Municipal Transport Corporation (EMT, bus) and Metrovalencia (tube). 2022



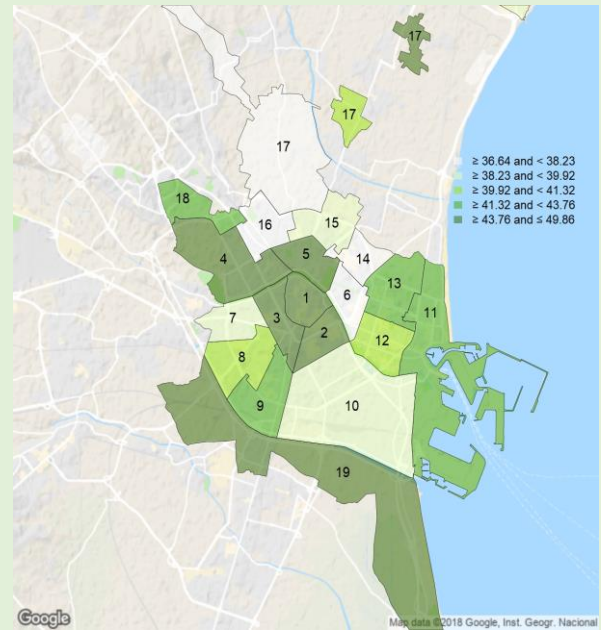

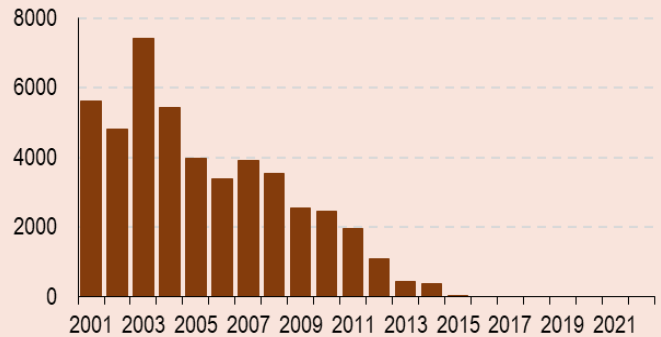

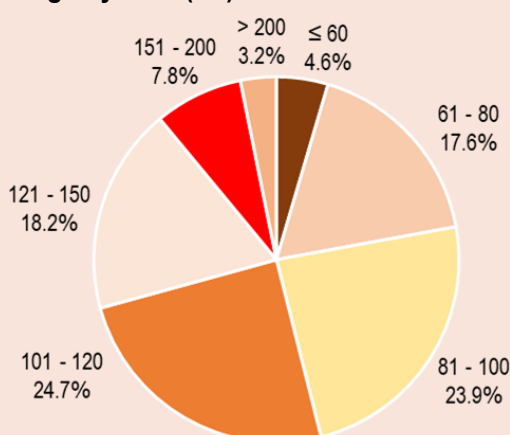

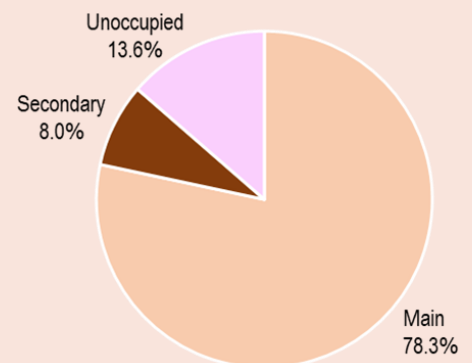

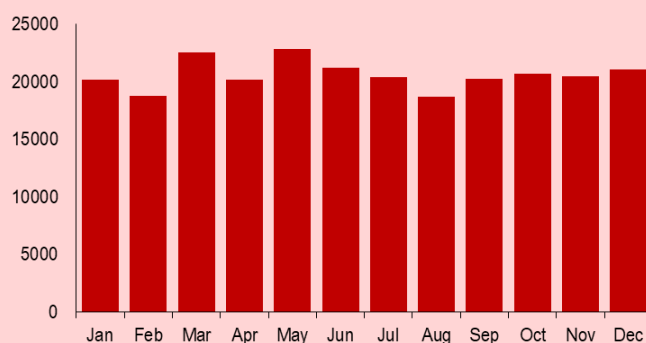

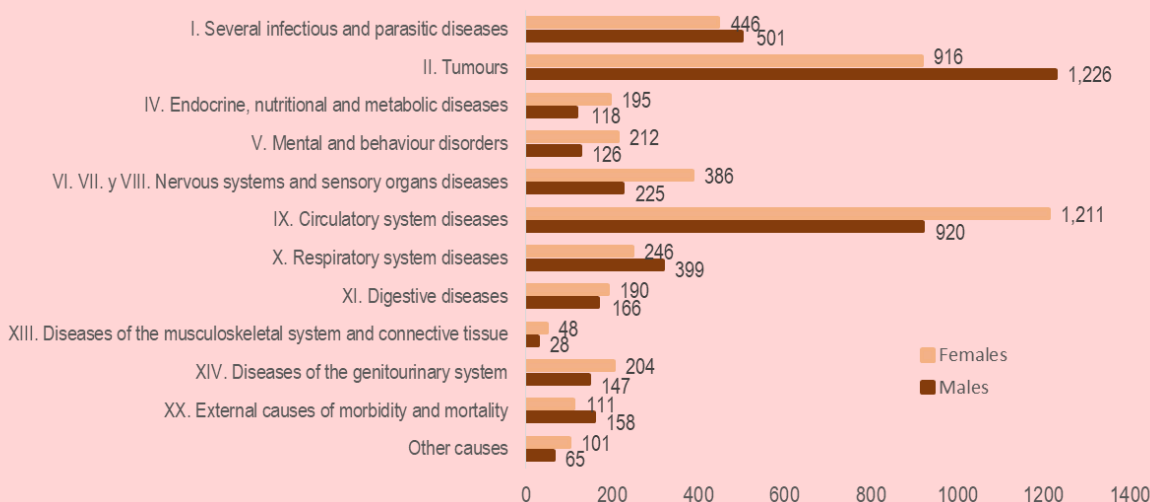

### Deaths by cause (XXI chapters of the ICD-10) and gender. 2021



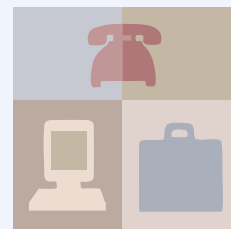

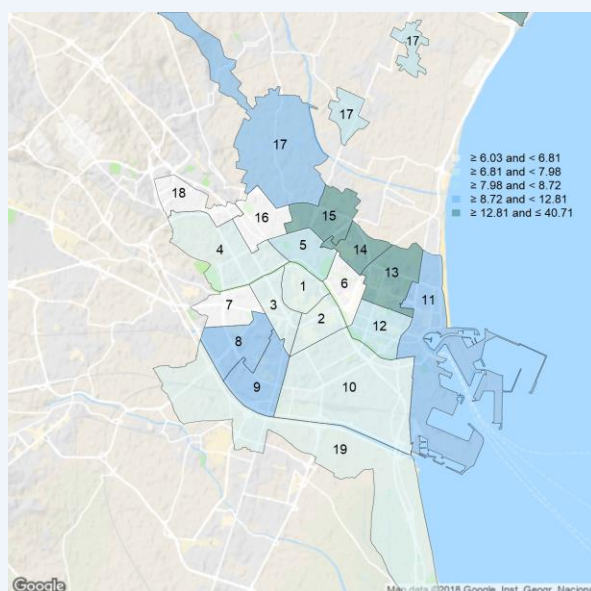

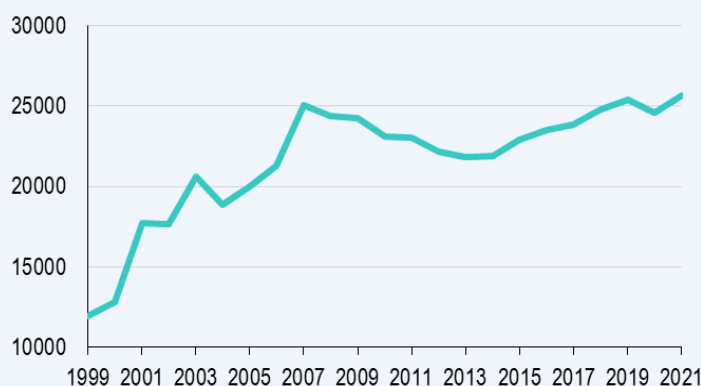

## Evolution of average taxable income (€)



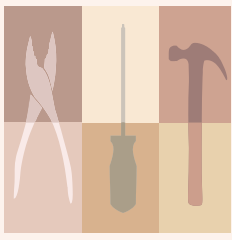

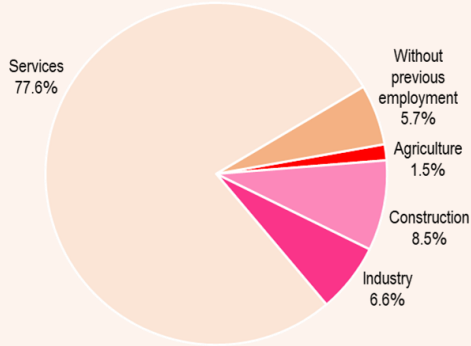

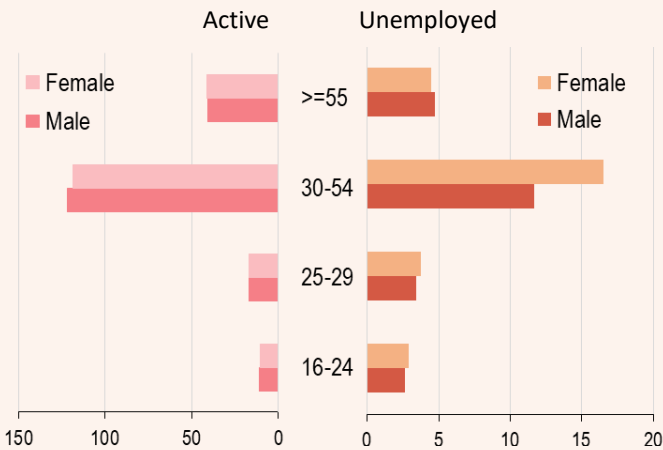
Registered unemployment by economic sector.

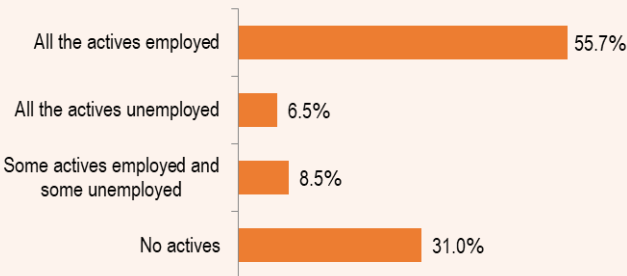

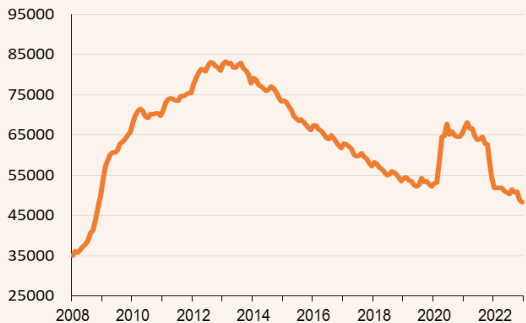

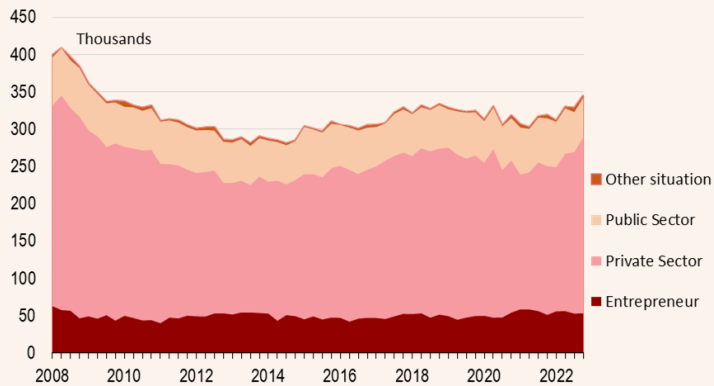
Evolution of registered unemployment.



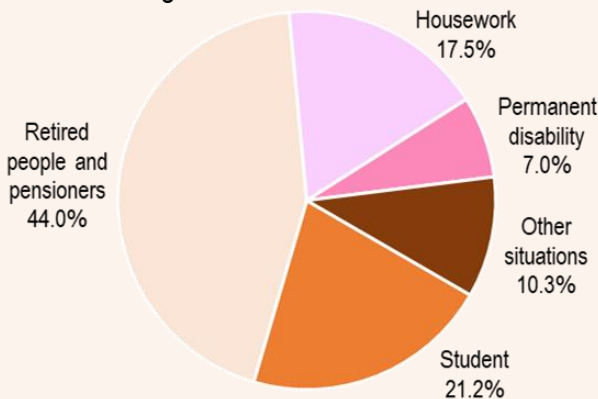

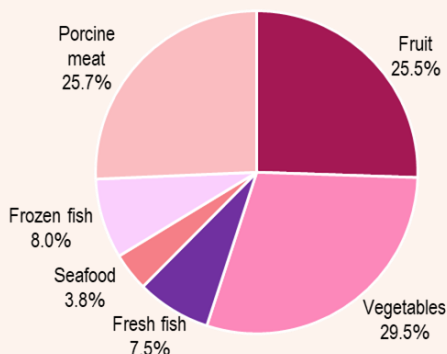

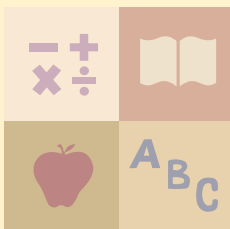

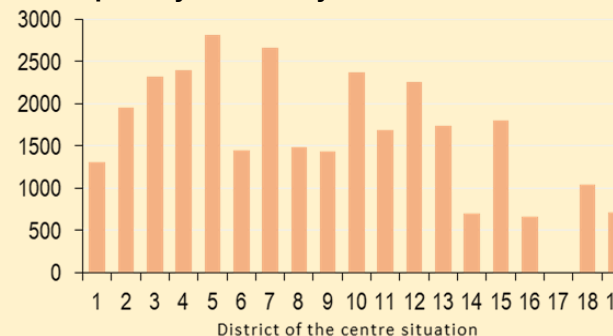
## Preschool Education. Academic year 2022/03



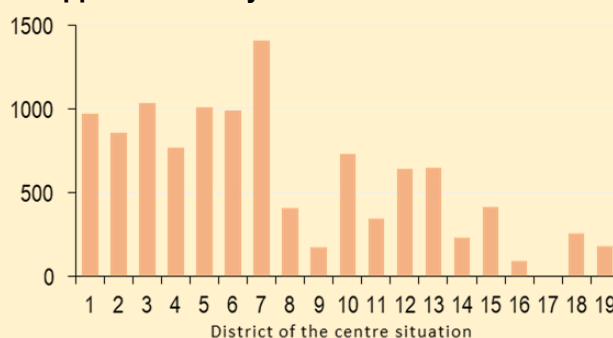

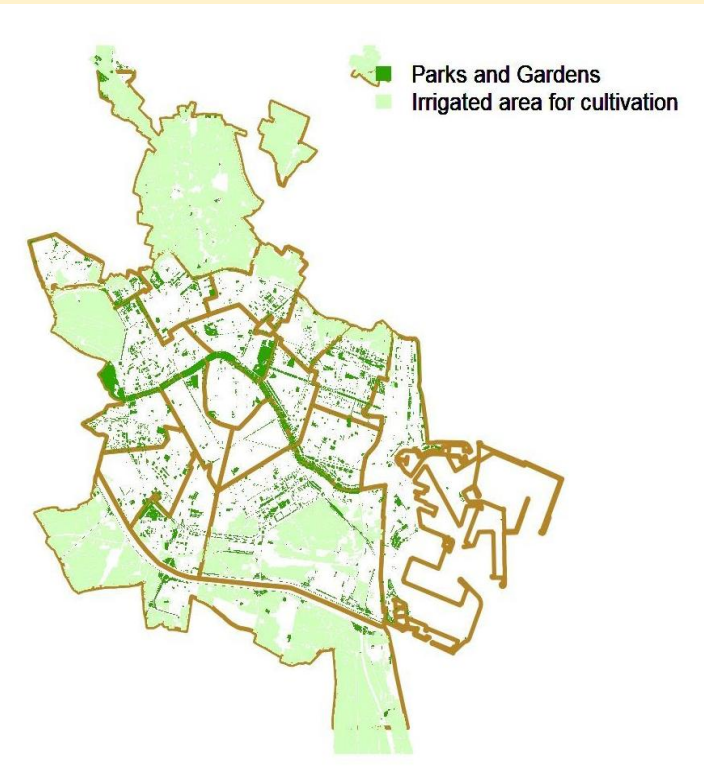

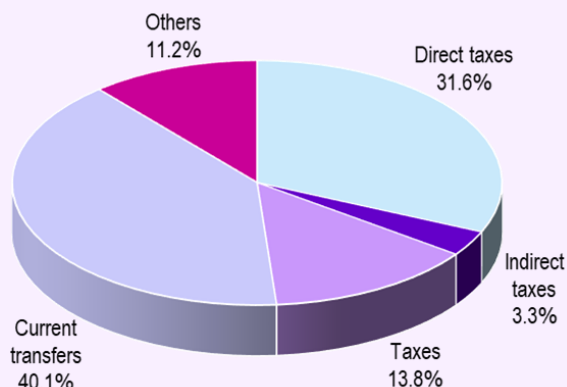

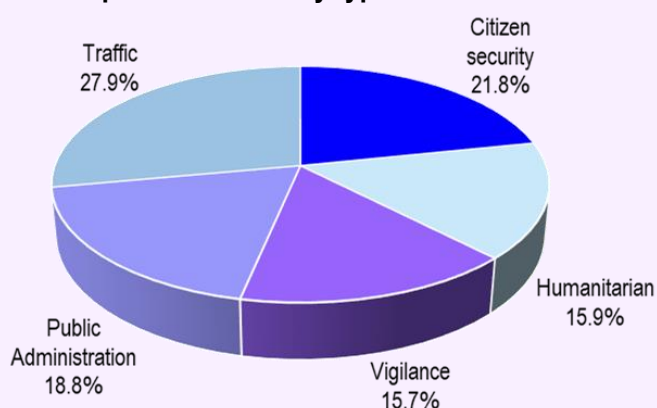

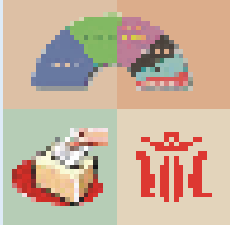

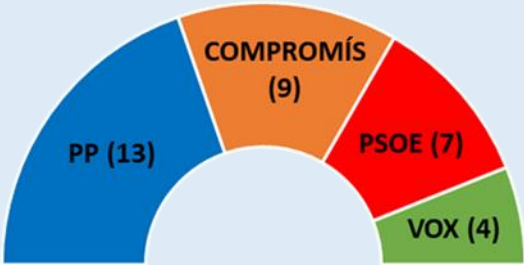

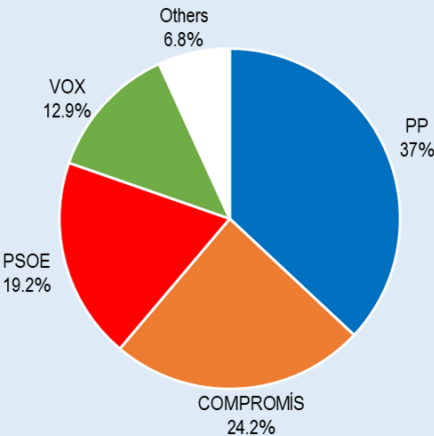

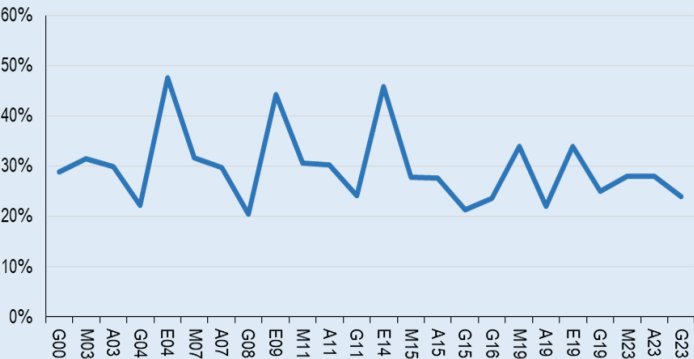

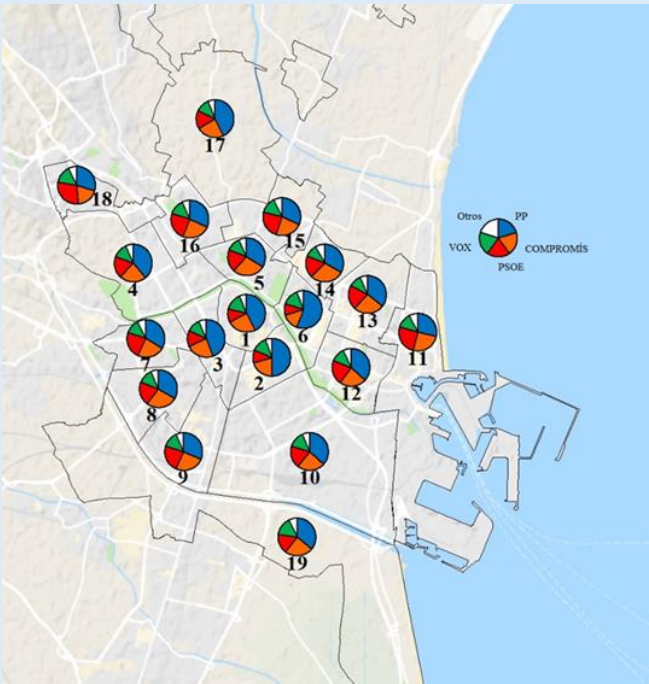
